Event Description:

The Gold Coast Cycling Club has been conducting the Darren Smith Classic for the last 30 years in memory of Olympic cyclist, Darren Smith, who was tragically killed in a cycling accident in 1992. The event was originally conducted from Elanora on a course that took in Mount Tomewin and northern NSW before finishing back in Elanora. It then moved to a road circuit at Pimpama for several years before moving to the Gold Coast Cycle Centre in Nerang where it was staged between 2004 and 2017. Between 2018 and 2020 the event moved to a challenging road circuit around Hinze Dam.

In 2021 the road race took place on a 26km circuit starting from Mt Alford State School in the Boonah area. Due to the successful running of the event around the Mt Alford course, the event will again be conducted on the same Mt Alford course in 2024.

Day 1: The criterium will take place at the Luke Harrop Cycle Centre, Runaway Bay, Gold Coast. Day 2: The road race will start and finish at Mt Alford State School, Mt Alford. The course is a 26km circuit in an anticlockwise direction. The event will comprise of 8 Races. The road race is a round of the QCRS – Qld Classic Road Series and the QRTS – Qld Road Team Series managed by AusCycling.

The criterium and the road race do not form a stage/tour event. They are two separate events and there are no carry over points or stage times.



DSC Criterium Race Details

Registration:

- All riders will receive two numbers. For the criterium TWO race numbers are to be worn on either side of the back in a vertical position (AC Tech Reg 1.00.04). See picture.
- Riders who are NOT racing in the road race are to return transponders to the number return area of the registration desk (riders will be charged at \$95 for each transponder not returned).
- Riders who are racing in the road race, keep the two numbers and transponder to use at the road race.
- Placegetters return to the podium area near the start / finish line for presentation in correct attire.

Racing:

- Racing will be in an anti-clockwise direction.
- Marshal and briefing will be on the eastern loop of the track 10 minutes before the beginning of the race.
- After the race, riders may complete one warm-down lap and exit the track at the western gate to the carpark.
- Spares must be placed in the signed area near the finish line. No neutral spares.
- Commissaire permission is required to race with an on-board camera. You cannot race with headphone devices.
- For most races, there will be 2 grades on the track at any one time. For rider safety, and to ensure fair and competitive racing for all riders, please follow these rules:
 - If you are passing another grade, pass on the outside of the track, and maintain speed until well clear of the other grade.
 - Your race is neutralised while another grade passes. Ride on the inside of the track and slow down to allow safe passing. Do not chase the passing grade.
 - Riders are not permitted to obtain an unfair advantage by joining/riding on the back of another grade.
 - When another race is given the final lap bell, give them the respect of a clear, safe run to the finish.

Junior Roll Out:

Junior riders U17 must comply with AusCycling regulations for junior gearing, which can be found <u>here</u>. All U17 Men & Wome roll-out before marshalling for their race/s. Rolls outs will commence at **7:30am**. **U17 = 7.0m**

First Aid: A first aid officer will be based at the start/finish line. Assist First Aid



Riders will compete in 'Races'. Within each race there may be multiple grades that normally demonstrate similar abilities and average speeds. Riders within a race are competing as a group, e.g., if a rider attempts to breakaway, anyone, regardless of grade, may work with that rider. However, in order for all riders to have the opportunity to feel competitive in their race, enjoy the event and have the opportunity to stand up on the podium, the Gold Coast Cycling Club **will be presenting podiums for all grades within each Race**. The Gold Coast Cycling Club also proactively promotes equal prizes for women and men where possible.

This event is part of the Queensland Classic Road Series. This is a points-based series, and as such, depending on points, series leaders will be presented with QCRS jerseys with each grade podium presentation. AusCycling will be responsible for the calculation of points, publishing of tables and awarding of series jerseys.

Food, Drinks and Toilets:

Commissaires and course marshals will be supplied with items such as muffins, sandwiches, fruit and cold drinks (no coffee!). Toilets are located inside the school and the adjacent park public toilets. At this stage there will be no canteen run by the Club, however there will be a **coffee van present**. A voucher system will be used with the coffee van. There are hot meals and coffee available at the Mt Alford Hotel and Scenic Rim Brewery just 100m away.



Registration, Race Bib Colours & Ranges:


- Registration and rider sign-on opens at 7.00am and is under the school building.
- Riders still need to sign on even if they raced in Saturday's criterium.
- All riders will receive two numbers. For the road race TWO race numbers are to be worn on either side of the back in a vertical position (AC Tech Reg 1.00.04). See picture.
- All transponders to be returned at the end of the road race or riders will incur a fee (\$95).
- Riders may keep their race numbers.





Convoy Drivers:

We would like commissaires and volunteers to be on site from 7:00am onwards.

Drivers, please ensure you have **a full tank of fuel** when you arrive. All convoys will be assembled at the same time due to the close start times. Once you arrive in the carpark, we will assist you in moving your vehicle into the correct position.

If you are driving a convoy vehicle you must pick up your **SIGN, LIGHT & RADIO**. There are **2 signs** for your vehicle to be stuck on the front and back. These can be found at the official's area and must be signed out with our volunteer's coordinator. In between your two races there will be a short break to go to the toilet and restock before assembling and heading back out for the second convoy window. It is important that you can do the races you have been assigned to, as it is very difficult to find a replacement if you decide to leave. **Please make sure you have been to the toilet first before heading out**.

Commissaires:

Please follow the same general instructions above in relation to positioning your vehicle. The PCP will provide you with more specific instructions in regard to how the convoys and riders are managed.

Please ensure you have picked up your **SIGN (x2), LIGHT & RADIO.** Moto Comms will also be supplied with a convoy sign and a numbered vest. If you are a commissaire, you have arrived early, and you have your **SIGN, LIGHT & RADIO,** the course is open for you to drive before the event commences.

U17 Junior Roll Outs: 7:40am onwards. U17 will be required to roll out as per usual. This will take place on the path near the official's tent in the official's carpark 30 minutes prior to the race. U17 convoy commissaires to complete roll outs.



Briefing:

Riders will be briefed on the finish line by the commissaires adjacent to the start finish line. Convoy vehicles that are required in front of the peloton should line up on the course in front of the field with the rest of the convoy situated behind the field in the carpark. Lead vehicles should always be well ahead of the peloton before riders begin their descent of the climbs.

Neutral Zone:

The race will start neutrally until the commissaires have decided that all riders are properly on course after which the red flag will be withdrawn and the race will officially start. A red flag will be provided to either Comm 2, the Lead vehicle or the Moto Comm depending on convoy composition.


Feed Zone: ** 2024 PCP (Chief Comm) decision is to allow feeding on the 2nd lap of all races **

The Feed Zone is located after the start/finish line on Mt Alford Rd extending for 80m (see map below). Unless additional provisions are made by the commissaires, feeding is not permitted during the first 30km and the final 20km of a race. One lap of the DSC circuit is 26km. Therefore, the following groups are permitted to feed:

Race 1, 2, 3, 4 & 8: Feeding is being permitted on lap 2 Race 5 (131km): Men A – laps 2, 3, 4 & 5 Race 6 (105km): Men B / Masters A – laps 2, 3 & 4 Race 7 (79km): Women A – lap 2 & 3

Waste Zone:

This course has a dedicated waste zone. There will be a waste zone 200 meters prior to the left hand turn on Ganthorpe Rd, where riders will be allowed to dispose of their water bottles and rubbish. This will be cleaned up at the end of the last race. **Fines will be imposed by the commissaires if riders litter outside the Waste Zone.**



Spares:

- Spare wheels are to be placed in the signed vehicle e.g.: 'Convoy C Spares' (See below. Convoy category for each Race is also denoted on the flyer). Vehicles will be found in the official's carpark near Registration. Please collect spare wheels from this area after the race.
- Please ensure your wheels are labelled with name and race category.
- Riders should be prepared to attend to their own mechanical issues where possible and are encouraged to carry a pump and spare tube should you fall behind the spares vehicle.
- Spares will be on a "spares in, spares out basis". Neutral spares may be available. It may not be possible for spares vehicles to carry all spare wheels. Volunteers will do their best to include wheels of each specification in the vehicle.
- There are no rider/team support vehicles allowed on the course.

KOM/QOM:

Races with **3 laps or less** will accumulate KOM/QOM points every lap. Races with **more than 3 laps** will not accumulate points on the first lap. First 3 places in the KOM/QOM will receive points (3, 2, 1). **Only first 3 riders across the line for each race, irrespective of grade, will be allocated KOM/QOM points**. Points are not allocated per grade. See KOM/QOM points and presentation schedules below. The KOM/QOM is located 6.2 km from the start/finish line.


Official Car Parking:

The school staff carpark adjacent to the finish line will be reserved for volunteers and commissaires (see site map above). Convoy vehicles will be lined up around the perimeter of the carpark ready to move out.

Competitor Car Parking – School Oval:

Entry: All competitors must enter the traffic-controlled holding slip lane in order to gain access to the oval car park. This is to ensure that the finish straight is kept clear of vehicles. If there has been recent rain then the school oval may not be useable and therefore competitors be will asked to park along the road.
