

# 2024-25 Gravity Series Rules & Regulations

### **General Rules**

- A rider must act in a sporting manner at all times and must permit any faster rider to overtake without obstructing.
- If a rider exits the course for any reason, he/she must return to the course between the same two course markers where he/she exited.
- In case a rider fails to return to the course, the commissaires' panel can disqualify the rider.
- The riders must respect nature and must make sure that they do not pollute the course venue.
- Anyone who is found to have altered the course has his/her accreditation removed or, in case of a rider, is disqualified.

## **Race Plates**

Race plates cannot be cut, altered, modified or wrapped around handlebars and must be clearly visible for race marshals and timing officials at all times. It is critical transponders that plates must be placed away from the forks where possible. Your race result may **NOT** be recorded if you modify or wrap your number plate around the handle bars and may result in a DQ.

## **Concussion Rule**

If you have been involved in an incident and suspected of a concussion must be thoroughly assed and monitored by a healthcare professional. All participants must receive medical clearance before returning to competition. In case of a multi-day event clearance must state that they are cleared medically to compete for the duration of the event. Please see the Thredbo Concussion Policy for further detail.

## **Ricochet Rumble**

7 December Start at Ricochet turn off

## **Competition Format**

One timed run per competitor with 30 second intervals.

#### Rules

- Riders must ride between the marked tape.
- In the event of the rider leaving the marked course, they will be disqualified if a time advantage is gained by short cutting.
- All bikes must have a minimum of front suspension and two disc brakes.
- Full face non-detachable helmets meeting the Australian Standards for off road use are mandatory for all competitors.
- Knee pads are mandatory for all competitors.

**NOTE:** The Commissaire and/or Race Director will decide if riders are eligible for a re-run. Their decision is final.

## Seeding

Seeding will run in ascending plate order; however we are happy for riders to self-seed where possible.

#### **Marshals**

10 marshals spread out across the racecourse.

# **Pump Track**

## 7 December Village Green Pump Track

### **Competition Format**

One timed run per competitor with 30 second intervals.

One inside lap and one outside lap in any order.

#### Rules

- Riders must ride between the marked tape.
- In the event of the rider leaving the marked course, they will be disqualified if a time advantage is gained by short cutting.
- The bike should have at least 1 rear brake.
- Full face non-detachable helmets meeting the Australian Standards for off road use are mandatory for all competitors.
- Knee pads are mandatory for all competitors.
- A minimum wheel size of 20 inches is required for the men and women open categories.

**NOTE:** The Commissaire and/or Race Director will decide if riders are eligible for a re-run. Their decision is final.

## Seeding

Seeding will run in ascending plate order; however we are happy for riders to self-seed where possible.

#### Marshals

2 marshals spread out across the racecourse.

# **Cruiser Crusher**

# 25 January Start at top of Cruiser Chairlift

#### **Competition Format**

One timed run per competitor with 30 second intervals.

#### Rules

- Riders must ride between the marked tape.
- In the event of the rider leaving the marked course, they will be disqualified if a time advantage is gained by short cutting.
- All bikes must have a minimum of front suspension and two disc brakes.
- Full face non-detachable helmets meeting the Australian Standards for off road use are mandatory for all competitors.
- Knee pads are mandatory for all competitors.

**NOTE:** The Commissaire and/or Race Director will decide if riders are eligible for a re-run. Their decision is final.

Seeding will run in ascending plate order; however we are happy for riders to self-seed where possible.

- All bikes must have a minimum of front suspension and two disc brakes.
- Full face non-detachable helmets meeting the Australian Standards for off road use are mandatory for all competitors.
- Knee pads are mandatory for all competitors.

- Riders must ride between the marked tape.
- In the event of the rider leaving the marked course, they will be disqualified if a time advantage is gained by short cutting.
- All bikes must have a minimum of front suspension and two disc brakes.
- Full face non-detachable helmets meeting the Australian Standards for off road use are mandatory for all competitors.
- Knee pads are mandatory for all competitors.

**NOTE:** The Commissaire and/or Race Director will decide if riders are eligible for a re-run. Their decision is final.
