## THE SERIOUS STUFF

- The Wagga Cycling Club intends for this carnival to be interactive and most importantly, FUN. We are not racing for Sheep Stations, so please ride sensibly and in the manner in which racing should be conducted.
- Entry to and from the track is via the main gate on the northern side of the facility, not over the fence.
- Be at the marshalling area at the entrance gate well before the start of your race.
- You will need to be in the Marshalling Area down on the warm up square two races prior to your event
- Poor behavior towards the Commissaires will not be tolerated and their decision will be final.
- Riders and handlers are not permitted to cross the track while a race is in progress; PENALTY - exclusion from your next event.
- Participation, under 9 and Under 11 may have a held start
- Handicaps – Juniors and Seniors will need their own pusher; please have this organised prior to the event.
- Hands on handlebars always
- Two numbers need to be displayed by all riders; left hip and on the lower back.
- Prizes and prize money apply to all races.
- Please be respectful of the facility and place rubbish in the bins provided.
- The criterium track will be available for Parking however, it will also be available to the general public.
- Roll out will be done at the start of the carnival along with the top 5 place getters of each junior event
- During warm up, slow riders above the blue line, fast riders below the blue line
- Following your race, a maximum of one lap cool down is allowed, then roll onto the infield.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Parking for this event is in the Wagga City Golf Club car park and Bollards will be opened to access the Criterium Track for parking. THIS IS ALSO A PREDESTRIAN WALK WAY!!!!
- Similar to Dunc Gray, there is a slight uphill walk and a trolley setup is recommended to get your belongings from the carpark to the track.
- Limited spaces for tents and/or gazebos are available. Early arrival to secure your spot is recommended.
- A Canteen will be in operation and Athletes from the Southern Sports Academy will be selling tickets for the 2024 Kidsons and Wagga Cycle Centre Raffle \$20 per ticket. Cash Preferred. Bank deposit available.

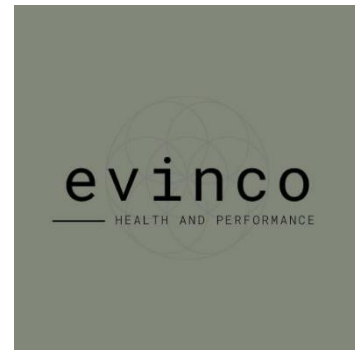
