The below categories will be run for the Jingili All Stars. In order for a category to be held, at least three (3) riders must be registered in that category.

Challenge (Standard 20")	Male	8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16-24
Challenge (Standard 20")	Female	8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13-15, 16-24
Masters	Male & Female	25+



ENTRY PROCESS & COST

Entry will be online via EntryBoss and at the club. Entries will be uploaded into Sqorz after entries have closed. It is the rider's/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category, and plate number.

TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except Mini Wheelers and Sprockets) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this event.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active subscription.
- Transponders can be purchased from Jingili BMX Club.

EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

- All riders are required to attend the Event Registration.
- All riders must take their bike to the transponder checking station to register for the event.
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct at the transponder checking station.

RACE INFORMATION

RACE FORMAT

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.03.03 a) of the AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX Racing.

The race format for the Jingili All Stars is as follows:

Mini Wheelers	30 minutes of track time
Sprockets	4 Motos
Challenge / Masters 25+	4 Motos, Qualifiers, Finals



MINI WHEELERS & SPROCKETS

All Mini Wheelers and Sprockets will receive a medallion for their participation.

CHALLENGE AND MASTERS CATEGORIES

For Challenge and Masters categories, the following will be provided:

DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS / PRIZE MONEY

All race participants will receive their awards on the day of racing.

JINGILI ALL STAR AWARD AND PERPETUAL TROPHY

This trophy will be awarded to the rider who places first in their nominated class with the most consistent lap times.

Criteria

- The rider must come first in all motos, including finals
- If a rider's race class is merged, scoring will be based on their position in their nominated race class
- A rider may nominate up. However, will be scored on the race class that they were nominated in and not on their age as of 31st of December
- The rider with the smallest time between their fastest and slowest moto times (including all finals) will be deemed the winner
- No additional entry is required. All riders in Challenge Class (including Masters) are automatically entered

You will receive a trophy on the day of racing, along with your name being added to a perpetual trophy, which will remain in the registration hut at Jingili BMX Club.



The following are prohibited at Jingili BMX Club:

- Pets
- Smoking (including E-Cigarettes or other vaping devices)

All attendees at the Jingili All Stars are required to adhere to the <u>National Integrity Framework</u> Failure to do so, or to follow any reasonable direction provided by Jingili BMX Club, or appointed officials at the event, may result in removal from the venue or exclusion from competition.
