1 OVERVIEW

The 2025 AusCycling BMX Racing National Series is made up of seven (7) rounds that are held throughout the year.

2 EVENT CATEGORIES

The Event Categories that will be held during each round of the BMX Racing National Series and will count towards the National Series Points, are listed below:

Category	Class	Eligibility
Challenge (20")	Male/Female	8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60+
Challenge (Cruiser)	Male/Female	8-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60+
Masters	Male/Female	30+
Junior Superclass	Male/Female	14-16
Superclass	Male/Female	16+

The following Participation Categories that will be held during the rounds of the National Series, but will not count towards the National Series Points, are listed below:

Category	Class	Eligibility
Sprockets	Male/Female	5 and under, 6, 7
Mini Wheelers	No Gender Division	2-7

Please Note: In accordance with the [AusCycling BMX Racing Technical Regulations](#), Riders may only enter their correct racing age and gender category for all National Rounds.

3 ENTRY COST

Entry for each National Series Round will be via EntryBoss. The cost of entry will be:

Note: The entry fees outlined are for race entry per round. Where two (2) rounds are being held on the same weekend and riders wish to participate in both rounds, they will need to enter pay for both rounds.

4 SERIES QUALIFICATION

The minimum qualification for the 2025 AusCycling BMX Racing National Series is five (5) of seven (7) rounds.

Please Note:

1. To be eligible for National Series points:
 2. The rider must enter their actual age and gender category
 3. Series Points will only be issued to competitors who ride in the extra Moto/Final at each round, in accordance with 2.05.04 of the [BMX Racing Technical Regulations](#)
- If eligible, riders may enter in Superclass (including Junior Superclass) or the Masters category and qualify for points in those categories.
- The category a rider enters their first round of the National series is the category they must enter in for the whole series. This includes Challenge, Cruiser, Masters, Junior Superclass and Superclass categories

5 NATIONAL SERIES POINTS

The AusCycling BMX Racing National Series points will be awarded based on the overall finishing place within each round, in accordance with the table below:

6 NATIONAL SERIES POINTS CALCULATION

National Series points will be calculated by adding the highest attained points from each round, based on the overall finishing place (rank) within each round.

The maximum number of rounds where points can be used for the series calculation is equal to the number of rounds used for qualification. For clarity, the maximum number of rounds for the National Series is Five (5).



6.1 MERGED CATEGORIES

In the scenario where categories have been merged at an event (for whatever reason), points will be awarded to the rider as per the entered category of the rider. For example, if a rider is merged into a category and is placed third in that category but is the first finisher in their entered age category, they will receive first place points.

6.2 TIE BREAK

When competitors share the same number of total series points ties will be broken using the following method:

1. The competitor with the highest number of points earned, in a single event, that counts towards their series total, is awarded the better rank.
2. If still tied, the next highest points for each rider are compared, and so on, until all events that contribute to their series total are exhausted.

7 ON THE DAY NATIONAL ROUND AWARDS

For each of the National Rounds the following awards will be presented:

7.1 PARTICIPATION CATEGORIES

All Sprockets/Mini Wheelers will receive an award for participation.

7.2 CHALLENGE CATEGORIES

For Challenge categories (20" & Cruiser), the following will be provided:

Prize	Placing	Allocated
Trophy	1st Place – 8th Place	Based on category on day ¹
<i>¹ The award is issued based on the category run on the day at the event (i.e. if categories are required to be merged, such as 8 Girls being merged with 9 Girls, then they are issued based on the merged category, which would be 9 Girls).</i>		
Note: Categories of 1 full gate or less will be run in accordance with section 2.05 of the BMX Racing Technical Regulations .		



7.3 MASTERS, JUNIOR SUPERCLASS AND SUPERCLASS CATEGORIES

For Masters, Junior Superclass and Superclass categories, the following will be provided:

Prize	Placing	Allocated
Prize Money*	1st Place (33%), 2nd Place (23%), 3rd Place (14%), 4th Place (8%), 5th Place (7%), 6th Place (6%), 7th Place (5%), 8th Place (4%)	Based on category entered ¹
¹ The award is issued based on the category entered (i.e. if categories are required to be merged, then prizing is issued based on the results of the riders for the category that they entered, being Junior Superclass Women or Junior Superclass Men).		
Note: Categories of 1 full gate or less will be run in accordance with 2.05 of the BMX Racing Technical Regulations .		

*Total Prize Pool is as follows:

- Superclass Women = \$1,500.00
- Junior Superclass Women = \$375.00
- Masters Women = \$375.00
- Superclass Men = \$1,500.00
- Junior Superclass Men = \$375.00
- Masters Men = \$375.00

8 END OF SERIES AWARDS

At the conclusion of the final event in the series, the following awards will be presented:

8.1 CHALLENGE (20" AND CRUISER) CATEGORIES

The 2025 National Series Awards for Challenge categories (20" & Cruiser) are as follows:

Prize	Placing
Trophy	1 st Place, 2 nd Place, 3 rd Place
Presentation Plates	1 st Place, 2 nd Place, 3 rd Place, 4 th Place, 5 th Place, 6 th Place, 7 th Place, 8 th Place

*Riders who receive a National Series presentation plate, will be permitted to register with their relevant plate number (i.e., 1NS, 2NS, 3NS) until the completion of the 2026 AusCycling BMX Racing National Series (for clarity this is the conclusion of the 2026 GWM BMX Racing National Championships) or until the same series event is next completed.



8.2 MASTERS, JUNIOR SUPERCLASS AND SUPERCLASS CATEGORIES

The 2025 National Series Awards for Masters, Junior Superclass and Superclass categories are as follows:

Prize	Placing
Prize Money*	1st Place (50%), 2nd Place (30%), 3rd Place (20%)
Presentation Plates	1 st Place, 2 nd Place, 3 rd Place, 4 th Place, 5 th Place, 6 th Place, 7 th Place, 8 th Place

*Prize Money is as follows:

- *Superclass Women = \$3,000.00*
- *Junior Superclass Women = \$750.00*
- *Masters Women = \$750.00*
- *Superclass Men = \$3,000.00*
- *Junior Superclass Men = \$750.00*
- *Masters Men = \$750.00*

*Riders who receive a National Series presentation plate, will be permitted to register with their relevant plate number (i.e., 1NS, 2NS, 3NS) until the completion of the 2026 AusCycling BMX Racing National Series (for clarity this is the conclusion of the 2026 GWM BMX RACING National Championships) or until the same series event is next completed.

8.3 AWARD PRESENTATIONS

These awards will be presented at the conclusion of the 2025 AusCycling BMX Racing National Series – Round 7. Further information on the exact presentation details to be communicated closer to the event date.

All awards & prizing (excluding any prize money) will be issued at the conclusion of the event.

All awards and prizing (excluding prize money) must be collected at the event. Please note that awards not collected by riders during the event will not be mailed afterward. Any unclaimed awards will be forfeited.

Riders who are eligible to receive prize money, are to provide their payment details within seven (7) days of the conclusion of the event) through the online form: link to be provided closer to event
