3 EVENT ENTRIES

Please read the below information carefully regarding event entry.

3.1 EVENT CATEGORIES

The below categories will be run for the 2025 AusCycling BMX Racing National Series. For a category to be held, at least five (5) riders must be registered in that category.

Challenge (Cruiser)	Male/Female	8-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60+
Masters	Male/Female	30+
Junior Superclass	Male/Female	14-16
Superclass	Male/Female	16+

Please Note: In accordance with the <u>AusCycling Technical Regulations: BMX</u>, Riders may only enter their correct racing age and gender category for all National rounds.



3.2 ENTRY PROCESS & COST

Entry will be online via EntryBoss only. Entries will be uploaded into Sqorz after entries have closed. It is the rider/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category, and plate number.

Riders who have entered and are no longer able to attend, can use the EntryBoss scratching mechanism prior to the Scratching Cut Off listed above. After this date has passed, to obtain a refund, riders must submit a medical certificate to events@auscycling.org.au, in line with the AusCycling Refund Policy.

Please Note: The request, accompanied by a medical certificate must be received no later than the day prior to the first day of official practice, and upon consideration by AusCycling, you may be eligible for a full or partial refund.



3.3 MIGHTY 11's REGULATIONS

Round 1 will be a Mighty 11s Test Team – Qualification for Event 1. Riders wishing to be selected for the Mighty 11s Test Team will need to enter the Mighty 11s Test Team Qualifiers category by completing the online entry, there will be an option when entering the National Round to add the Mighty 11's category if you wish to be a part of this event. All riders entered will race their respective 20" category, with times from all races (motos, qualifiers and finals) used to determine the four (4) male and four (4) female riders selected to represent Australia in the Mighty 11s Test Team. A reserve male and female rider will also be selected

Please note: the rider must have already completed the online entry form for the 2025 AusCycling BMX Racing National Series – **Round 1** Shepparton in their respective 20" category, to be included.

3.4 MEMBERSHIP

The events will be open to all riders holding an AusCycling Race Membership: All Disciplines or Off Road only. No four (4) week trial or day licenses are permitted.

3.5 TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except Sprockets and Mini Wheelers) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this
 event.
- 20" and 24" bikes will need separate transponders unless prior approval has been received.
- It is the riders responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active subscription. Transponders can be purchased here.

3.6 EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

- All riders are required to attend the Event Registration (sign on).
- All riders must take their bikes to the transponder checking station to register for the event.
- Riders entered in two (2) categories (i.e., 20" and 24") must take both bikes to register in both categories.
- Parents and guardians must scan Sprocket/Mini Wheeler membership at the transponder checking station.

4 RACE INFORMATION

4.1 RULES AND REGULATIONS

The event will be conducted under the BMX rules and regulations of AusCycling (AC) and the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI). This Technical Guide is supplementary to the following:

4.2 RACE FORMAT

Current UCI Rules apply using Scrambled Moto transfer system for all categories except for participation. Block format may apply pending rider entries. Gate positions for Motos will be random computer drawn. Total points to end of motos followed by Qualifiers and Finals. Gate positions for Qualifiers and Finals are in order of lap time from the previous Stage or Round.

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.05 of the <u>AusCycling Technical Regulations</u>: <u>BMX</u>.

The race format for the National Round 1 & 2 is as follows:

Masters	3 Motos, Qualifiers, Finals
Junior Superclass	3 Motos, Qualifiers, Finals
Superclass	3 Motos, Qualifiers, Finals

5 ON THE DAY AWARDS & PRIZING

5.1 PARTICIPATION CATEGORIES

All Sprockets/Mini Wheelers will receive an award for participation.



5.2 CHALLENGE CATEGORIES

For Challenge categories (20" & Cruiser), the following will be provided:

¹ The award is issued based on the category run on the day at the event (i.e. if categories are required to be merged, such as 8 Girls being merged with 9 Girls, then they are issued based on the merged category, which would be 9 Girls).

5.4 DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS & PRIZING
