Discipline Specific Selection Criterion

2025 UCI ENDURO (EDR) & E-ENDURO (E-EDR) WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

29 August - 1 September 2025, Aletsch Arena Switzerland Elite and U19 Men and Women – Enduro Elite Men and Women – E-Enduro

1. General

- I.I Athletes will be required to earn 2025 UCI Enduro and E-Enduro World Championships Team selection in accordance with the *AusCycling Selection Policy for UCI World Championships*, and this discipline specific document of the AusCycling (AC) selection criteria.
- 12 Objectives: See clause 1 of the AusCycling Selection Policy for UCI World Championships.
- **I.3** Performance Time Period: 27 Aug 2024 8 June 2025
- I.4 In the case of extenuating circumstances being approved under clause 4 of the *AusCycling Selection Policy for UCI World Championships*, the Selection Panel may consider the results in the 6 months prior to the performance period.
- **1.5 Team size**: Refer to clause 3.3 of the *AusCycling Selection Policy for UCI World Championships*.
- 1.6 Expression of Interest: To be eligible for nomination to the Australian Team, athletes MUST submit an expression of interest by the closing date listed in section 4 of this document. Athletes that do not submit an expression of interest will not be considered by the selection panel, regardless of meeting any other eligibility criteria or minimum performance standards.
 The expression of interest form will be located at https://auscycling.org.au/about/high-performance/selection from the published open date.
- 1.7 The submission of an Expression of Interest is **solely the responsibility of the athlete** seeking selection
- 1.8 Once an athlete is selected, they must provide a performance plan for the World Championships to the Operations Manager MTB for approval. Team members without an approved performance plan will not be entered in the event. The rationale for the inclusion of this clause is to ensure all selected athletes have sufficient support on the ground at the World Championships. Currently, AusCycling does not have the resources to provide full staffing on the ground.

A performance plan must include, but not limited to details on:

- Professional Team (if applicable) OR.
- Support staff (including mechanic)
- 1.9 In extraordinary circumstances, and if team quotas allow, the Selection Panel may, at their absolute discretion, add additional athletes to the team after the initial team selection processes have been followed, and if all selection criteria, objectives and minimum performance standards are met.



2. Selection Eligibility Criteria

2.1 Junior Specific Eligibility

- 2.1.1 Specific eligibility for the Junior (U19) Athletes will be based on the principle that those athletes be in formal education or training and remain engaged in that education or training course to completion throughout the 2025 UCI MTB World Championships selection and competition periods. This requirement will be given weight by the Selection Panel but will not be mandatory. Education may include but are not limited to:
 - a) Secondary School certificate of Education (i.e. SACE, VCE, International Baccalaureate (IB);
 - b) TAFE and/or Vocation Education Training (VET) (i.e. Traineeship, Apprenticeship);
 - c) Tertiary Study. i.e. Undergraduate degree
- 2.1.2 Athletes who are unable to satisfy the education or training requirements of clause 2.1 will need to provide reasons to the Selection Panel as why this is the case. The rationale for the inclusion of this clause is that AusCycling does not believe it is generally in the best interests of junior athletes to docus solely on cycling at this point in their development.



3. Selection Events and Selection Criteria

3.1 Selection Events:

Subject always to the *AusCycling Selection Policy for UCI World Championships*, the Selection Panel may, at their absolute discretion, consider athletes for selection to the 2025 UCI Enduro and E-Enduro World Championships team based upon performances in the competitions listed in clause 3. The Selectors may, at their absolute discretion, weight events according to the level of competition, depth of field, the quality and difficulty of the course, and the relevance of the course in relation to the 2025 World Championships Course:

3.1.1 Enduro - Elite and U19 Men and Women:

- o UCI Enduro World Cups during the performance period;
- o 2024 AusCycling Enduro National Championships; and/or
- Other international results during the performance period. International results are defined as performances in UCI listed EDR events and may include events in Australia.

3.1.2 E-Enduro - Elite Men and Women:

- o 2024 AusCycling E-Enduro National Championships; and/or
- Other international results during the performance period. International results are defined as performances in UCI listed E-EDR events and may include events in Australia.

3.2 Selection Criteria

3.2.1 Enduro - Elite Men

- o Direct UCI Qualification:
 - Any rider ranked in the top 100 of the 2025 Enduro overall rankings
 - Any rider achieving a top 30 result at any round of the 2025 Enduro World Cup (Elite Men Category)
- O Additional riders that have submitted an EOI as outlined in clause 1.6, and at the absolute discretion of the Selection Panel, meet one or more of the objectives outlines in clause 1.2

3.2.2 Enduro Elite Women

Direct UCI Qualification:

- Any rider ranked in the top 50 of the 2025 Enduro overall rankings
- Any rider achieving a top 15 result at any round of the 2025 Enduro World Cup (Elite Women category)
- O Additional riders that have submitted an EOI as outlined in clause 1.6, and at the absolute discretion of the Selection Panel, meet one or more of the objectives outlines in clause 1.2



3.2.3 Enduro U19 Men

o Direct UCI Qualification:

- Any rider ranked in the top 100 of the 2025 Enduro overall rankings
- Any rider achieving a top 10 result at any round of the 2025 Enduro World Cup (U19 Men category)
- o Additional riders that have submitted an EOI as outlined in clause 1.6, and at the absolute discretion of the Selection Panel, meet one or more of the objectives outlines in clause 1.2

3.2.4 Enduro U19 Women

- Direct UCI Qualification:
 - Any rider ranked in the top 50 of the 2025 Enduro overall rankings
 - Any rider achieving a top 10 result at any round of the 2025 Enduro World Cup (U19 Women category)
- O Additional riders that have submitted an EOI as outlined in clause 1.6, and at the absolute discretion of the Selection Panel, meet one or more of the objectives outlines in clause 1.2

3.2.5 **E-Enduro - Elite Men**

- Direct UCI Qualification:
 - Any rider ranked in the top 100 of the 2025 Enduro overall rankings
- O Additional riders that have submitted an EOI as outlined in clause 1.6, and at the absolute discretion of the Selection Panel, meet one or more of the objectives outlines in clause 1.2

3.2.6 **E-Enduro - Elite Women**

- o Direct UCI Qualification:
 - Any rider ranked in the top 50 of the 2025 Enduro overall rankings
- o Additional riders that have submitted an EOI as outlined in clause 1.6, and at the absolute discretion of the Selection Panel, meet one or more of the objectives outlines in clause 1.2



4. Schedule for World Championships Team Selection

4.1 The timeframes for the selection process of the World Championships Team to contest the 2025 UCI Enduro and E-Enduro World Championships* are:

Selection Timelines

- o Monday, 20 May 2025 **Mandatory** Expressions of Interest Open
- o Monday, 16 June 2025 (5PM AEST) **Mandatory** Expressions of Interest Close
- o Friday, 27 June 2025 (5PM AEST) Final team selections forwarded to AusCycling CEO for endorsement.
- o Tuesday, 1 July 2025 (5PM AEST) Athletes receive confidential notification of selection / non-selection to the BMX SX World Championships Team
- o Thursday, 3 July 2025 (5PM AEST) Closing date for appeals to be lodged against non-selection (refer to the AusCycling Selection Appeals Policy for UCI World Championships, clause 7)
- o Monday, 7 July 2025 Week scheduled for appeal hearings, if required
- o Monday, 14 July 2025 (5PM AEST) Final Enduro and E-Enduro World Championship Team announced by AusCycling

*Selected athletes may be required to pay a levy to attend the 2025 UCI Enduro World Championships. Estimated levy costs will be provided closer to selection.

4.2 Changes to schedule

4.2.1 AusCycling reserves the right to change the above listed dates if more time is needed to ensure due process and fairness in selection and compliance with UCI entry dates
