1. OVERVIEW

The Queensland Classic Road Series events are a critical part of the Racing competition structure in Queensland and will in 2025 include a club competition. The following are the series specific regulations.

3. ENTRY FEE

Each race is hosted by one of our clubs who set the entry fee for each individual.



4. SERIES POINTS INDIVIDUAL

The points for the Series will be awarded based on the finishing place on each stage in accordance with the following table:

In the event of a tie after the completion of the series, the best result in Round 6 will be the deciding factor.

5. SERIES POINTS CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

The total points of all the clubs riders will be recorded plus 5 additional points for each rider finishing the race, For any DNF riders they will receive 3 points.

The Champion Club will be those with the most accumulated points covering all categories at the conclusion of the Series.



6. EVENT CATEGORIES

The Event Categories that will be conducted and recognised accordingly in series points, are as listed below:

7. GRADING

- Queensland road gradings will be used for all races.
- If a competitor is moved up a grade, then they will take 50% of their points with them to the new grade.
- Clubs will continue to run their current Division with combined grades when required. Riders will be placed for points based on their current Queensland Grade in races that combine grades.
- U17 competitors, where catered for, will accumulate points for the grade within which they race.
