Discipline Specific Selection Criterion

2025 UCI JUNIOR TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Junior Men and Women 20-24 August 2025, Apeldoorn, Netherlands



1. General

- I.I Athletes will be required to earn 2025 UCI Junior Track World Championships Team selection in accordance with clause 1 of the *AusCycling Selection Policy for UCI World Championships*, and this discipline specific document of the AusCycling (AC) selection criteria.
- 12 Objectives: See clause 1 of the AusCycling Selection Policy for UCI World Championships.
- I3 Performance Time Period: 15 November 2024 31 March 2025
- 1.4 Team size: Refer to clause 3.3 of the *AusCycling Selection Policy for UCI World Championships,* the maximum world championship team (WCT) size is subject to UCI allocated quotas. AC reserves the right to not fill any WCT quota. Unless otherwise determined by the AC Board, the Chair may exercise the right of AC under this clause to not fill all UCI quotas. Where athletes exceed qualified quotas, the Panel in its sole discretion will determine which athletes are to be selected.
- **Dual World Championship Selection:** U19 athletes available for selection in more than one discipline, within the same calendar year, will be considered for both World Championship Teams.



2. Selection Eligibility

- Specific eligibility for the 2025 Junior Track World Championships will be based on the principle that those Athletes must be in formal education or training and remain engaged in that education or training course to completion throughout the 2025 Junior Track World Championships selection and competition periods. Education may include, but not be limited to;
 - Secondary School Certificate of Education (i.e., SACE, VCE, or International Baccalaureate (IB) etc
 - TAFE and/or Vocational Education Training (VET) (i.e., Traineeship or Apprenticeship)
 - Tertiary study (i.e., Undergraduate degree)
- 2.2 Athletes who are unable to satisfy the education or training requirements of clause 2.1 will need to provide reasons to the Selection Panel as to why this is the case. The rationale for the inclusion of clause 2.1 is that AusCycling does not believe it is generally in the best interests of junior athletes to focus solely on cycling at this point in their development.



3. Selection Criteria and Performance Standards

SELECTION CRITERIA

- 3.1 Consideration for selection to the 2025 Junior Track World Championship Team may be based upon achieving:
 - 3.1.1 Performances in Section 3 of this document, and/or in accordance with clause 2.2 of the AusCycling Selection Policy for UCI World Championships, where Selectors may use absolute discretion to select athletes based on their potential to progress to Podium category within 5-years once out of U19.
 - 3.1.2 If athletes attain performances in the events listed below at 3.3.1 and/or times in 3.3.2, they will be automatically eligible for consideration to the world championship team.
- 3.2 Where more athletes meet the criteria than there are places available, Selectors may use absolute discretion to rank athletes according to some or all of the factors in clause 2.2 of the AusCycling Selection Policy for UCI World Championships.

EVENTS AND PERFORMANCE STANDARDS

3.3 The Selection panel may consider the competition performance results and standards indicated below for:

3.4 Selectors may consider results achieved in other major national and international level events Track competitions within the performance time period such as UCI sanctioned international events, and AusCycling approved events including State Championships (for timed events only).



4. Schedule for World Championships Team Selection

4.1 The timeframes for the selection process of the World Championships Team to contest the 2025 UCI Junior Track World Championships are:

Selection Timelines

- Sunday, 13 April 2025 (5PM AEST) Deadline for submission of recorded performances for selection purposes (AusCycling internal deadline),
- Thursday, 17 April 2025 (5PM AEST) National Selection Panel meets to consider athletes for selection to the World Championship Team.
- Thursday, 17 April 2025 (5PM AEST) Final team selections forwarded to AusCycling CEO for endorsement.
- Tuesday, 22 April 2025 Athletes receive confidential notification of selection / nonselection to the Junior Track World Championships Team
- Thursday, 24 April 2025 (5PM AEST) Closing date for appeals to be lodged against non-selection (refer to the AusCycling Selection Appeals Policy for UCI World Championships, clause 7)
- Week of Monday, 5 May 2025 Week scheduled for appeal hearings, if required
- Week of Monday, 12 May 2025 Final 2025 Junior Track World Championship Team announced by AusCycling.
