

Discipline Specific Selection Criterion

2025 UCI TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Elite Men and Women

22 -26 October 2025, Santiago, Chile

1. General

- I.1 Athletes will be required to earn 2025 UCI Track World Championships Team selection in accordance with clause 1 of the *AusCycling Selection Policy for UCI World Championships*, and this discipline specific document of the AusCycling (AC) selection criteria.
- I.2 Objectives: See clause 1 of the AusCycling Selection Policy for UCI World Championships.
- I.3 Performance Time Period:

Elite men and women:

1 July 2024 – 24 August 2025
- I.4 Team size: Refer to clause 3.3 of the *AusCycling Selection Policy for UCI World Championships*.

2. Selection Eligibility and Criteria

- 2.1 **UCI qualification articles 9.2.027bis** (as per 2.1.1 below), will be applied when making selections for events for the 2025 UCI Track Cycling World Championships

2.1.1 A Nation will only be allowed to enter a rider in a specific event of the Elite World Championships if the following conditions are fulfilled:

- o Where applicable, the nation must have participated in this specific event in at least one leg of the Nation's Cup of this season. This only applies when the specific events are scheduled at each leg of the Nation's Cup.*
- o Where applicable, the nation must have participated in this specific event in the most recent Elite Continental Championships.*



3. Selection Criteria and Performance Standards

SELECTION CRITERIA

- 3.1 Consideration for selection to the 2025 UCI Track Cycling World Championships Team may be based upon achieving:
- I. Performances in Section 3 of this document, and/or
 - II. In accordance with clause 2.2 of the *AusCycling Selection policy for UCI World Championships*, where the Selection panel may use absolute discretion.
- 3.2 Where more athletes meet the criteria then there are quota places available, selectors may use absolute discretion to rank athletes according to some or all of the factors in clause 2.2 of the *AusCycling Selection Policy for UCI World Championships*.

PERFORMANCE STANDARDS

- 3.3 The Selection panel may consider the performance standards indicated below for Elite Men and Elite Women **Olympic Events**: Sprint, Keirin, Team Sprint, Team Pursuit, Omnium and Madison.
- 3.4 In Team events (Team Pursuit, Team Sprint and Madison) the selection panel may consider an Athlete's contribution to the overall event performance, as determined by the National Head Coach for Acceleration and Action and/or the National Head Coach for Endurance.
- 3.4.1 For Team Pursuit selections, the selection panel may also consider athlete performances in an event or trial approved by the Head Coach – Endurance, that meet the performance standards indicated below in Individual Pursuit,
- Elite Men Individual Pursuit <4:13
 - Elite Women 3km Individual Pursuit <3:28
 - Elite Women 4km Individual Pursuit <4:43

**Subject to AusCycling Trial Recording and Environmental Standardisation Protocol and recorded under 500m altitude and excluding Moscow velodrome for Sprint Flying 200m. For all selections, all considered performance times must be recorded on video as per the standards in the AusCycling Trial Recording and Environmental Standardisation Protocol. Where Podium Performances are considered as outlined above, these do not need to be obtained on a velodrome that meets the environmental standardization requirements i.e. can be achieved in competition on a velodrome above 500m, noting that the accompanying time will not be considered. In such circumstances, overall placing relative to strength of opposition will be considered.*

**1 athlete on the track when undergoing efforts. Standing efforts from gate with 10 second count down. All times to be recorded on standard issue team clothing and equipment.*

- 3.5 The selection panel, using absolute discretion, may consider selection to the non-Olympic events; Individual Pursuit, Kilometre Time Trial, 500m Time trial, Points Race, Elimination Race, and Scratch Race, subject to Australia, and the relevant athletes, meeting Nation and UCI athlete nomination eligibility.



4. Schedule for World Championships Team Selection

- 4.I The timeframes for the selection process of the World Championships Team to contest the 2025 UCI Track Cycling World Championships* are:

Selection Timelines

- Thursday, 28 August 2025 (5PM AEST) – Deadline for submission of recorded performances for selection purposes (AusCycling internal deadline)
- Wednesday, 27 August 2025 (5PM AEST) – Final team selections forwarded to AusCycling CEO for endorsement.
- Monday, 1 September 2025 (5PM AEST) – Athletes receive confidential notification of selection / non-selection to the Track World Championships Team
- Wednesday, 3 September 2025 (5PM AEST) – Closing date for appeals to be lodged against non-selection (refer to the AusCycling Selection Appeals Policy for UCI World Championships, clause 7)
- Week of Monday, 8 September 2025 - Week scheduled for appeal hearings, if required
- Week of Monday, 15 September 2025 (5PM AEST) - Final Track World Championship Team announced by AusCycling.
