2 CORPORATE TEAMS

2.1 NATIONAL SERIES

1	1 x Corporate Team Entry	February (<i>National Round 1</i>)^	\$80.00
2	1 x Corporate Team Entry	April (<i>National Round 2</i>)	\$80.00
3	1 x Corporate Team Entry	May (<i>National Round 3 & 4</i>)	\$160.00

Each Corporate Team Entry, will include:

- 1 x automatic entry into the 2026 AusCycling BMX Racing National Corporate Series
- 1 x Allocated Tent Site (**Excludes RD 1**. Exact location of this Allocated Tent Site will be provided ahead of event).
- Nomination of up to six (6) riders to the team. Riders can only be nominated in one (1) team per round.

Series Qualification:

- The minimum qualification for the 2025 AusCycling BMX Racing National Corporate Series is Three (3) of Four (4) rounds.

Calculation of Results:

- Points will be issued to riders for Motos and the Final (will not include Qualifiers), with the results of the top four (4) riders from each corporate team for each event added together.
- The top four (4) riders can come from any category (excluding Sprockets and Mini Wheelers).
- For riders entering more than one (1) category, the best results from one (1) of those categories will be considered.



- If you enter multiple teams in an event, they will be designated as Team 1, Team 2, and so on. Each team's results will be totaled separately at the end of the series. For example, points earned by Team 1 will only be added to Team 1's total, and points earned by Team 2 will only be added to Team 2's total.

End of Series Qualification/Prizing:

- At the conclusion of the final round in the National Series, the following awards will be presented:
 - Presentation plaque – 1st Place Team
 - 50% of the total income received from all 2026 Corporate Team Entry Fees for the Series will be put into a prize pool, with 1st place receiving 50% of the prize pool, 2nd place receiving 30% of the prize pool and 3rd place receiving 20% of the prize pool.
- End of Series points will be calculated by adding together the results of the top four (4) riders from each Corporate Team for each event. The maximum number of rounds where points can be used for the overall Series calculation is equal to the number of rounds used for qualification.
- The maximum number of rounds where points can be used for the series calculation is equal to the number of rounds used for qualification. For clarity, the maximum number of rounds for the Series is Five (5).

Please Note: There will be no on the day prizing.

2.2 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

Each Corporate Team Entry, will include:

- 1 x automatic entry into the 2026 GWM BMX Racing National Championships Corporate Teams
- 1 x Allocated Tent Site (exact location of this Allocated Tent Site, will be provided ahead of event).
- Nomination of up to six (6) riders to the team. Riders can only be nominated in one (1) team for the event.

Calculation of Results:

- Points will be issued to riders for Motos and the Final (will not include Qualifiers), with the results of the top four (4) riders from each corporate team added together.
- The top four (4) riders can come from any category (excluding Sprockets and Mini Wheelers).
- For riders entering more than one (1) category, the best results from one (1) of those categories will be considered.



End of Championships Prizing:

- At the conclusion of the 2026 GWM BMX Racing National Championships the following awards will be presented:
 - Presentation plaque – 1st Place Team
 - 50% of the total income received from all 2026 Corporate Team Entry Fees for the GWM National Championships will be put into a prize pool, with 1st place receiving 50% of the prize pool, 2nd place receiving 30% of the prize pool and 3rd place receiving 20% of the prize pool.

Please Note: There must be at least three (3) Corporate Teams entered per event, for Corporate Teams to run at that event.

2.3 HOW TO PURCHASE CORPORATE TEAM ENTRY

All Corporate Teams must be purchased through the AusCycling [Online shop](#). Corporate team entry product purchase will close 2 weeks prior to each event.
