3 EVENT ENTRIES

Please read the below information carefully regarding event entry.

3.1 EVENT CATEGORIES

The below Championship categories will be run for the 2026 Oceania BMX Racing Championships:

Championship (Junior)	Male/Female	17-18
Championship (U23)	Male/Female	19-22
Championship (Elite)	Male/Female	19+

The Challenge categories offered at the 2026 Oceania BMX Racing Championships will be in accordance with UCI Regulations 6.1.009 & 6.1.011

Mini Wheelers	No Gender Division	2 - 7
Sprockets	Male / Female	5 and under, 6, 7
Challenge (20")	Male / Female	8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35+
Challenge (Cruiser)	Male / Female	12 & Under, 13-14, 15-16, 17-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50+

Please Note:

- In accordance with the [UCI Regulations – BMX](#) Racing Riders may only enter their correct racing age and gender category.
- Riders entered Championship categories cannot enter Challenge categories.
- **Riders who enter a Championship category at the 2026 Oceania Championships, cannot then race in a Challenge category at the 2026 Australian National Championships & UCI BMX Racing World Championships.**

3.2 ENTRY PROCESS & COST

Entry will be online via EntryBoss only. Entries will be uploaded into Sqorz after entries have closed. It is the rider/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category, and plate number.

3.3 SCRATCHING & REFUNDS

Riders who have entered and are no longer able to attend, can use the EntryBoss scratching mechanism prior to the scratching cut off listed above in section 3.2. If a rider scratches in EntryBoss prior to the scratching cut-off date, they will automatically be refunded the entry fee via EntryBoss. After the scratching cut-off date has passed, in order to obtain a refund, riders must request a refund via email to bmx.events@auscycling.org.au, with a copy of their medical certificate attached. The refund request and medical certificate must be received by AusCycling prior to race day

3.4 MEMBERSHIP

All National Federations affiliated to the [Oceania Cycling Confederation](#) may take part in Continental Championship races.

- All riders holding a UCI Licence from a National Federation who is a member of the Oceania Cycling Confederation; or
- An Australian with an AusCycling Race Membership (All Disciplines or Off Road only); or
- A Member of Cycling New Zealand.
- Citizens of a National Federation within the Oceania Cycling Confederation, holding a Cycling licence for 2026.

All Riders entered in the **Championship & Masters Categories** must have a UCI ID.

3.5 TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except Mini Wheelers & Sprockets) will need to provide their own transponder to enter the event.
- 20" and 24" bikes will need separate transponders unless prior approval has been received.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active [subscription](#). Transponders can be purchased [here](#).

3.6 RACE PLATES

Championship Event

- Riders without a UCI International Elite Number will be assigned a number, in accordance with section 6.1.095 bis of the [UCI Regulations – BMX](#)
- Championship categories only will be issued an official Race Plate when they attend Event Registration.
- No frame numbers required.



Challenge Event:

- Riders must ensure they have the correct Race Plate as detailed under section **6.1.091b** of the UCI BMX Racing Regulations. (excluding sprockets and Mini Wheelers) Riders with duplicate plates in the same category may be required to add an 'X' on their race number.

3.7 JERSEYS

- The Oceania Cycling Confederation and UCI have provided an exemption to section 6.1.083 of the [UCI Regulations – BMX](#), allowing riders not to wear their National Jersey for this event. National Champions Sleeve Jersey's will only be recognised for the respective Championship categories as per UCI regulation **6.1.084**. For clarity Challenge riders will not be permitted to use a jersey with a distinctive sleeve.(ie A Sleeve with a AUST or NZ flag / Symbol on it.

3.8 EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

- All riders are required to attend the Event Registration (sign on), prior to the commencement of their Official Practice session. All riders (except Mini Wheelers and Sprockets) must take their bikes to the transponder checking station to register for the event.
- Riders entered in two (2) categories (i.e., 20" and 24") must take both bikes to register in both categories.
- Parents/guardians must scan participation membership at the transponder checking station, but they are not required to bring bikes with them.
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct at the transponder checking station.

4 RACE INFORMATION

4.1 RULES AND REGULATIONS

This event will be conducted under the BMX Racing Regulations of the Union Cycliste International (UCI).

4.2 RACE FORMAT

Current UCI Rules apply using Scrambled Moto transfer system for all categories except for participation. Block format may apply pending rider entries. Gate positions for Motos will be random computer drawn. Total points to end of motos followed by Qualifiers and Finals. Gate positions for Qualifiers and Finals are in order of lap time from the previous Stage or Round.

A category one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section **6.1.023** of the [UCI Regulations – BMX](#).

The race format for the Oceania Championships/Challenge is as follows:

Challenge awards and prizing will be issued based on categories raced on the day.

Championship Category prizing will be issued in accordance with 6.1.014 of the [UCI Regulations-BMX](#).

5.1 DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS & PRIZING

Challenge awards & prizing will be issued at the conclusion of the final race in each category.

The Championship & Masters categories presentation ceremony will commence approximately 15 minutes after the conclusion of the final race. Noting this presentation will only be for podium places. I.e. 1st, 2nd & 3rd.

Riders who are eligible to receive prize money, are to provide their payment details within seven (7) days of the conclusion of the event) through the online form: [2026 Oceania BMX Racing Championships - Prize Money](#)

Prize money will be paid via EFT, within twenty-one (21) days of the conclusion of the event (subject to riders providing their details in the listed timeframe).

Failure to do so, or to follow any reasonable direction provided by AusCycling, or appointed officials at the event, may result in removal from the venue or exclusion from competition.
