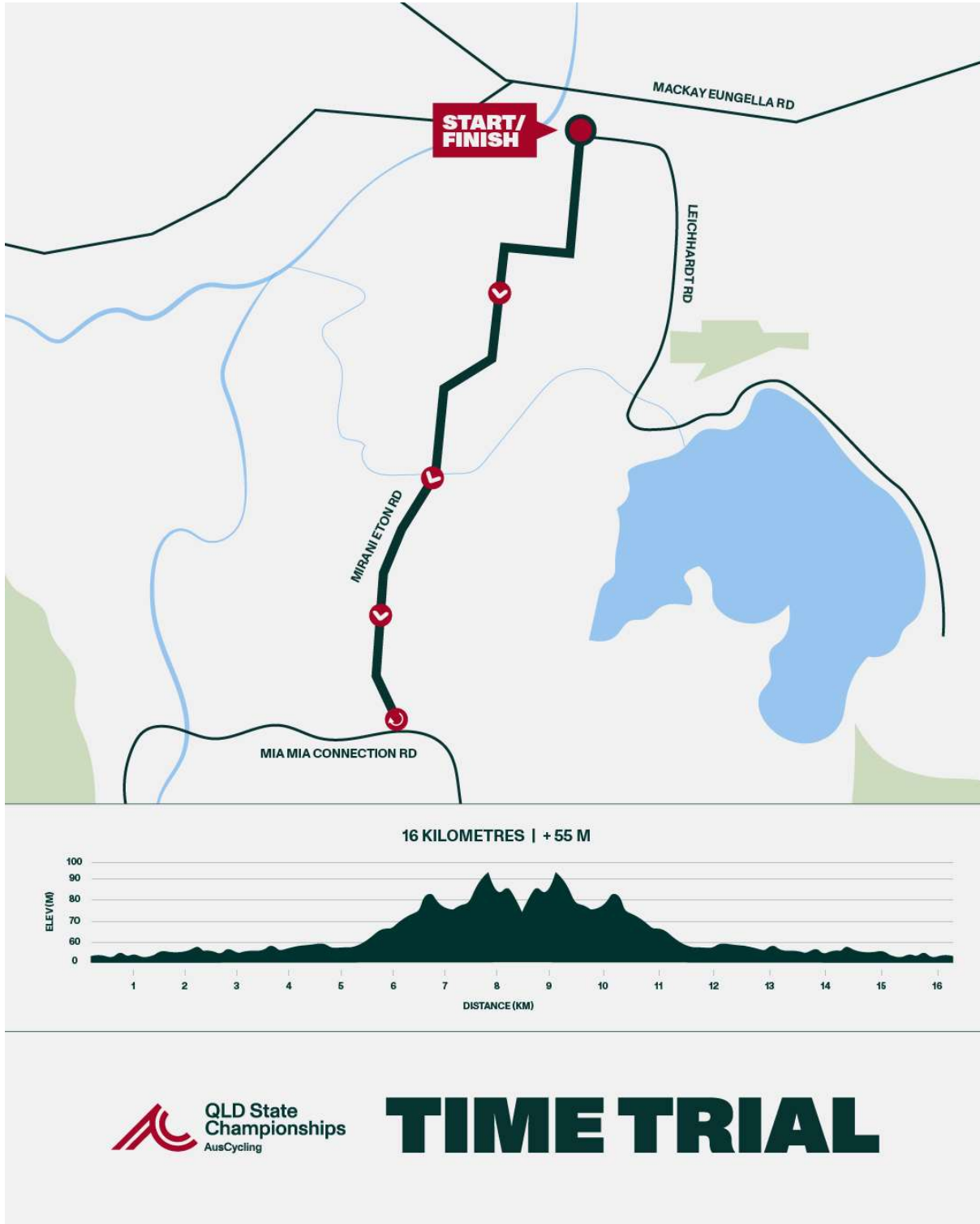

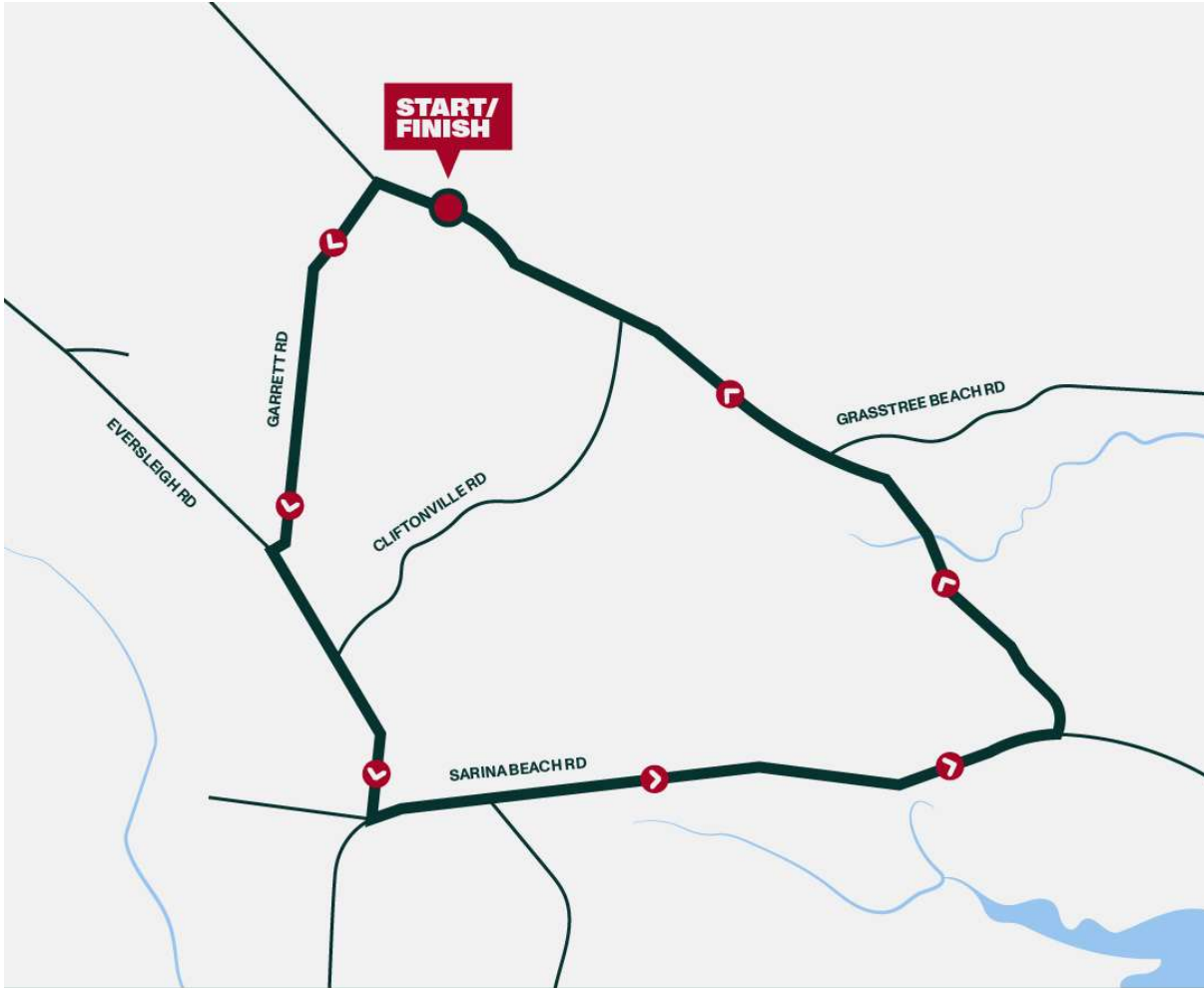

2. COURSE MAPS



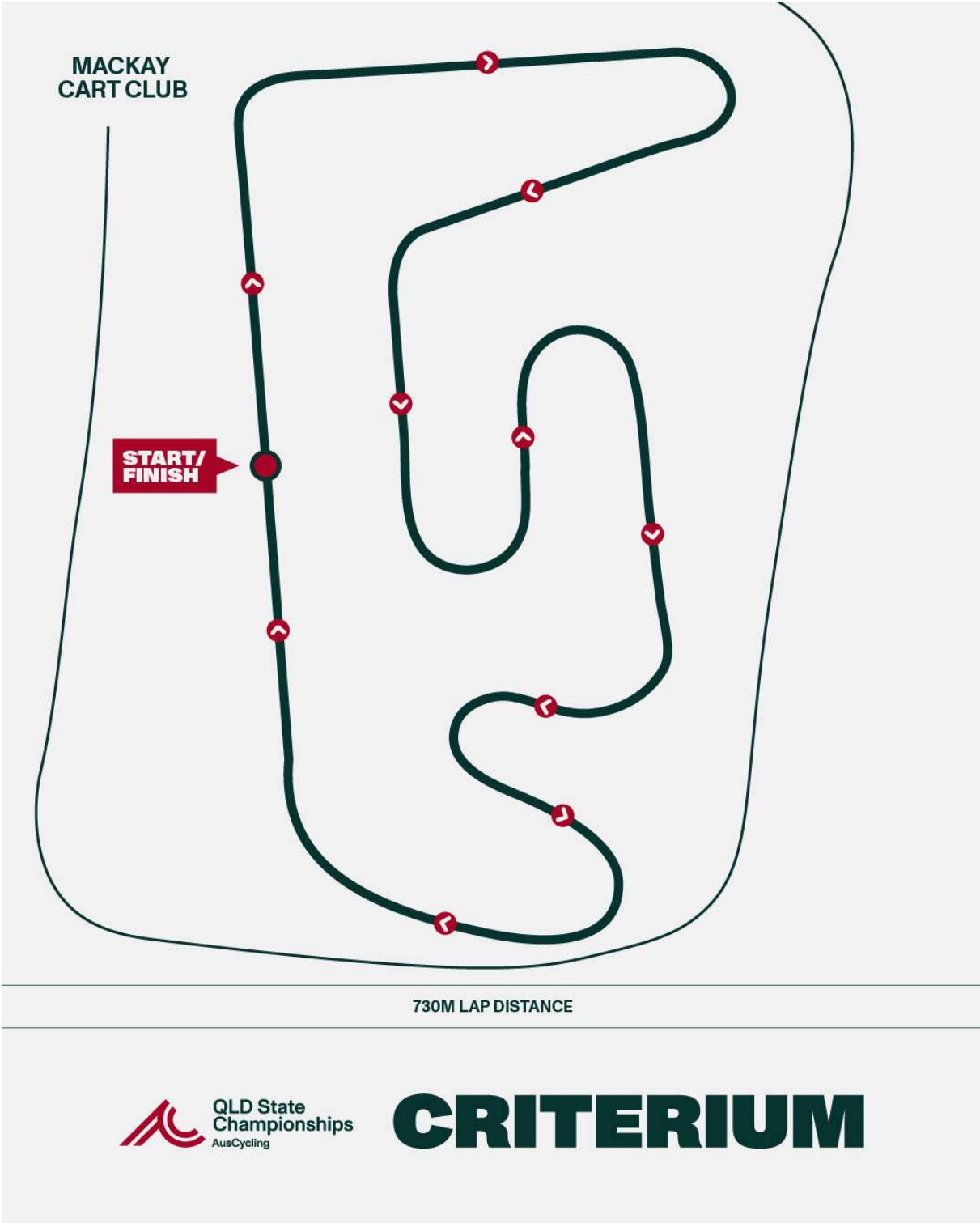

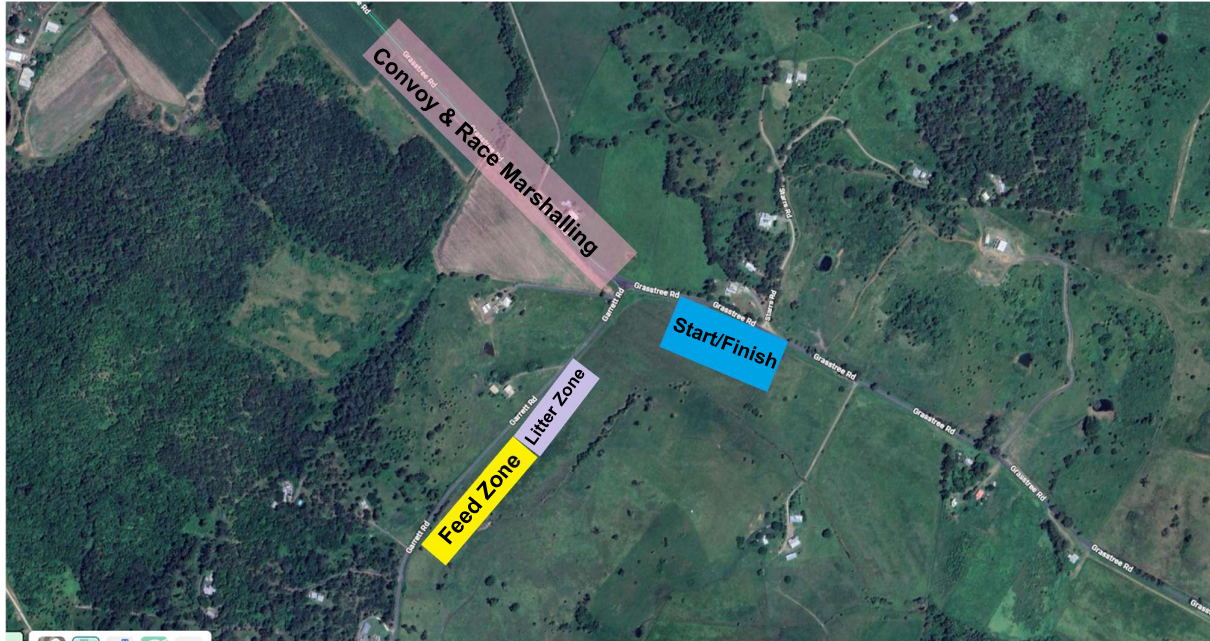


Site Plan – Individual Time Trial





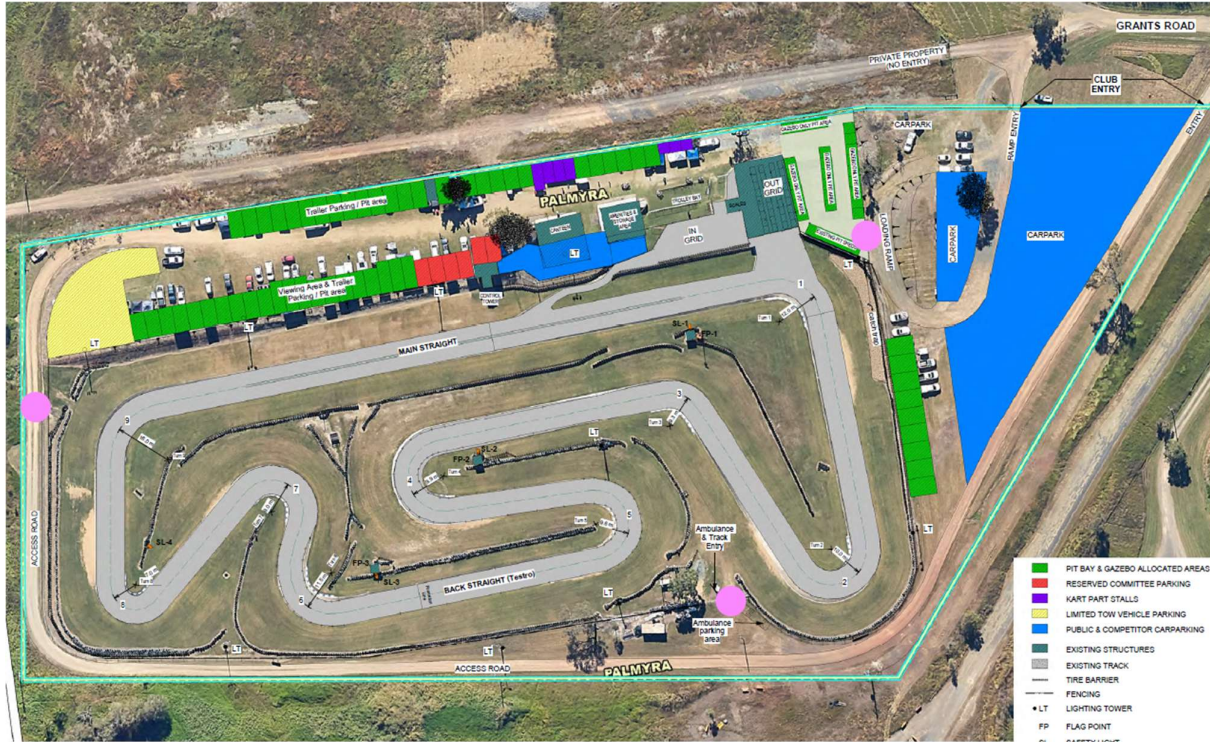
Site Plan – Road Race

4. EVENT INFORMATION

NATIONALS SELECTION

Any J15/J17 who wishes to compete at the Road National Championships must compete in a State Championship event to be eligible. Riders wanting to be selected in their respective State Team must compete in their own State Championship event, and riders entering individually must also have competed in a State/Territory Championship.

RACING ATTIRE

All competitors must be wearing either a plain kit or a club kit.

No team state team kit team kit will be allowed to be worn

As per 2.11.03 - Wearing of Jerseys: National/State and Territory Champions

3. When a rider no longer holds the title of Australian Champion the rider may wear National Champion bands on the collar and cuffs of their jersey. A rider may wear a jersey with National Champion bands only in the events of the discipline, specialty and category in which they won the title and no other event. Masters may wear a jersey with Australian Champion bands in all master's competitions of that discipline on an ongoing basis.

BIKE REGULATIONS

PRELIMINARY BIKE CHECK

Bikes will need to be checked before events have begun – see site map for the bike check location at Mirani.

TRANSPONDERS & RACE NUMBERS

You will be given your transponder at registration. Position the transponder on either fork using the supplied cable ties. Return your transponder & race numbers at the end of the event. Not returning a transponder & numbers will result in a fee of \$150.

For all events the transponder must be placed on the front fork (either side):



For the Individual Time Trial - 1 number must be placed in the low centre of the back





For the Road Race & Criterium – 2 numbers must be placed as shown in the diagram below.

SIGN ON

All riders must sign on for all races.

- Registration will open from 8:00am on Friday the 3rd of July outside the Mirani State School
- Registration will be open from 7:00am on Saturday the 4th of July outside the Alligator Creek State School



PARKING

Parking at Mirani for the individual time trial, there is plenty of street parking in front of the Mirani state school and the surrounding area. Please do not park on Mary Street, the council are doing works in the paddock area and require access to get in and out.

Parking for the Road Race is available in front of the Alligator creek state school and the surrounding area. The school is approx. 3km from the start/finish line. No parking will be allowed on the course at any times.

Parking available at the go kart circuit is as per site map.

TRAFFIC CONDITIONS

For the Time Trial - All entrants must come into the Mirani State school area via the main highway. We do not want any event traffic to be on the course at all once racing has started.

For the Road Race – All entrants are advised to come directly to the Alligator State School. Follow the Bruce Highway turn off at Hay point Road and then go along Grasstree Road. We do not want any event traffic to be on the course at all once racing has started.
