# 1 OVERVIEW

The 2026 Queensland Classic Road Series is an exciting series across 5 rounds of racing across Queensland. The series provides essential racing opportunities for Junior 19, Elite, U23, and Masters cyclists to compete at a regional level.

The following are the series specific regulations for Queensland

## 2 SERIES ROUNDS

---

- Round 1 | Anzac 25 & 20 – 25<sup>th</sup> April
- Round 2 | Metros Criterium & Road Race – 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> May
- Round 3 | Charles Coin & Mardi Bartlett – 18<sup>th</sup> July
- Round 4 | Darren Smith Classic – 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> August
- Round 5 | Lifecycle Classic – 30<sup>th</sup> August

## 3 SERIES QUALIFICATION

---

### PLEASE NOTE:

- To have your place recognised in the QLD Classic Road Series:
  - a. Riders require an AusCycling “RACE ALL DISCIPLINE” membership to participate in any QLD event.
  - b. This series is open to all J19, U23, Elite and Masters category riders.
  - c. Participation in all events is open to all riders within the appropriate age groups.
  - d. If a competitor is moved up a grade, then they will take 50% of their points with them to the new grade.
  - e. The rider must have earned points to appear in the series standings.



# 4 SERIES POINTS

---

The points for the Series will be awarded based on the finishing place on each Round in accordance with the following table:

# 5 CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

---

The total number of points by each club member is totalled up in a tally per round. Each round clubs will be able to gain bonus points calculated for the club championship will be awarded based on the below table:

The table below provides a list of entries per club per round – each club will attain bonus points if they can get more than 10% of the entries based off last year's participation. The table equates to how many more entries they need to get bonus points.

## 5 SERIES POINTS CALCULATION

---

Series points will be calculated by adding the total points earned on each round.

### 5.1 COMBINED/DIVIDED CATEGORIES

In the scenario where categories have been combined at an event (for whatever reason), points will be awarded separately. For example, if Women's C and Women's D have combined into one race, the combined result will be separated into a result for each category, with the full Series Points allocation applied to each.

### 5.2 TIE-BREAK

Should any riders finish on the same number of points at the end of the series, the tie will be broken by way of countback as follows:



- The number of 1<sup>st</sup> places achieved.
- The number of 2<sup>nd</sup> places achieved.
- The number of 3<sup>rd</sup> places achieved.
- The number of races started.

Should the tie remain after the countback, the riders will receive the same placing in the Series.
