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Before submitting an expression of interest, Athletes must read the [AusCycling Selection Policy for UCI World Championships-Olympic and Paralympic Sports \(the Policy\)](#) which details the selection process, objectives, eligibility and general selection criteria.

1. Elite athletes will be required to earn 2027 UCI BMX Freestyle World Championships Team (WCT) selection in accordance with the requirements set out in *the Policy*, and this discipline specific document of the AusCycling selection criteria.

2. ELITE OBJECTIVES

See clause 1 of *the Policy*.

3. PERFORMANCE TIME PERIOD

6 September 2026 – 15 June 2027 (inclusive)

4. EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

To be eligible for nomination to the WCT, athletes **MUST** submit an expression of interest by the closing date listed at clause 7 of this document. The expression of interest form will be located at <https://auscycling.org.au/athlete-selection-policies/u23-elite-selection-policies> from the published open date.

5. SELECTION EVENTS AND PERFORMANCE STANDARDS

All selections are subject to *the Policy*.

One Elite Male and one Elite Female will be selected by name based on the following:

a) Elite Men

Winner Overall, 2027 AusCycling BMX Freestyle Triple Crown Series 14+ Open Men

b) Elite Women

Winner Overall, 2027 AusCycling BMX Freestyle Triple Crown Series 14+ Open Women

Triple Crown Events: 2027 Beenleigh C1, 2027 AusCycling National Championships, 2027 Oceania Continental Championships

*UCI eligibility requires athletes to be 15 years of age or older. In the instance that a 14 year old wins the AusCycling BMX Freestyle Triple Crown series, they would not be eligible for selection.

In addition to the above automatic selections, when making additional selection decisions, the Panel will consider for selection any athletes who have achieved two or more of the specified level of results at the listed BMX Freestyle events during the Performance Time Period. Events and their associated performance

standards are listed in order of priority so that, for example, if it is necessary to compare the performances of athletes who have each met the Performance Standard in different events in the Elite Women category, a Top 8 Finish at a UCI FS Park World Cup event will, for example, be given greater weight than a Top 2 result at a C1 Park Event.

All selection decisions are however subject to *the Policy* and the fact that an athlete has met the Performance Standard at one of the higher priority listed events does not necessarily mean they will be selected over and above an athlete who has met the Performance Standard at a lower priority event if, taking into account the factors outlined at clause 3.3 of *the Policy*, the Panel considers that selecting the other athlete best meets the Objectives in clause 1 of *the Policy*.

c) Elite Men

1. Top 12 UCI FS Park World Cups
2. Top 12 UCI FS Park World Championships 2026
3. Top 4 HC Park Events
4. Top 3 Overall AusCycling BMX Freestyle Triple Crown Series
5. Top 3 C1 Park Events
6. Top 20 UCI BMX FS Individual Ranking
7. Winner 2027 AusCycling National Championships
8. Winner 2027 Oceania Continental Championships

d) Elite Women

1. Top 8 UCI FS Park World Cups
2. Top 8 UCI FS Park World Championships 2026
3. Top 3 HC Park Events
4. Top 3 Overall AusCycling BMX Freestyle Triple Crown Series
5. Top 2 C1 Park Events
6. Top 12 UCI BMX FS Individual Ranking
7. Winner 2027 AusCycling National Championships
8. Winner 2027 Oceania Continental Championships

Having met the above performance standards does not equate to automatic selection.

If (for example, due to illness or injury), an athlete has not achieved the abovementioned performance standards but has achieved podium results at other



major national and international level BMX Freestyle competitions within the Performance Time Period such as UCI sanctioned international events, and AusCycling approved events, the Panel may at its discretion consider those results. For the avoidance of doubt the Panel is under no obligation to consider results at events other than those listed above and a failure to do so will not provide a basis upon which to appeal the Panel's decision. Where the number of athletes meeting the performance standards is fewer than the number of available quota spots, the Panel may, in its absolute discretion, consider additional athletes who it believes have the potential to contribute to one or more of the objectives outlined in clause 1 of the Policy.

6. Where more athletes meet the criteria than there are places available, the Panel may use absolute discretion to rank athletes having regard to the objectives in clause 1 of the Policy and the factors in clause 3.3 of *the Policy*.

7. SELECTION TIMELINES
