3.1 EVENT CATEGORIES

The below categories will be run for this event. In order for a category to be held, at least four (4) riders must be registered in that category.

Superclass	Male/Female	16+

3.2 ENTRY PROCESS & COST

Entry will be online via EntryBoss only. Entries will be uploaded into Sqorz after entries have closed. It is the rider's/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category, and plate number.

The event will be open to all riders holding an AusCycling Race Membership: All Disciplines or Off Road Only. No Four (4) Week trial or day licences permitted.

3.3 SCRATCHING & REFUNDS

If scratching from the event after the close of entries, no refund will apply unless a medical certificate is provided via email to sheridan.codd@auscycling.org.au along with the refund request. The request, accompanied by a medical certificate, must be received no later than the day prior to the first day of competition, and upon consideration by AusCycling, you may be eligible for a full refund.

3.4 MEMBERSHIP

The event will be open to all riders holding an AusCycling Race Membership: All Disciplines or Off Road Only. No Four (4) Week trial or day licences permitted.

3.5 TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except Participation Categories) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this
 event.
- 20" and 24" bikes will need separate transponders unless prior approval has been received.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active <u>subscription</u>.
- Transponders can be purchased <u>here</u>.

3.6 EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

- All riders are required to attend the Event Registration (sign on) prior to their official practice.
- All riders must take their bikes to the transponder checking station to register for the event.
- Riders entered in two (2) categories (i.e. 20" and 24") must take both bikes to register in both categories.
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct at the transponder checking station.

4. RACE INFORMATION

4.1 RULES AND REGULATIONS

The event will be conducted under the BMX Rules and regulations of AusCycling (AC) and the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI). This Technical Guide is supplementary to the following:

- AusCycling Technical Regulations: General
- AusCycling Technical Regulations: BMX
- UCI Regulations BMX

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.03.03 a) of the <u>AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX Racing.</u> Noting awards / prizes will only be issued to competitors who ride in the extra moto/final.



4.2 RACE FORMAT

Current UCI Rules applies using Scrambled Moto transfer system for all categories except for participation. Block format may apply pending rider entries. Gate positions for Motos will be random computer drawn. Total points to end of motos followed by Qualifiers and Finals. Gate positions for Qualifiers and Finals are in order of lap time from the previous Stage or Round.

The race format for the 2024 AusCycling BMX State Series – ACT/NSW R7 Sydney BMX is as follows:

4.3 RACE PLATES

- Riders must ensure they have the correct Race Plate as detailed under section 3.02 of the <u>AusCycling</u> Technical Regulations BMX.
- Riders with duplicate plates in the same category may be required to add an 'X' on their race number.

4.4 RIDERS ADVOCATE

A Riders advocate will be appointed by the Technical Delegate (TD). The Riders Advocate represents a rider in relation to appeals concerning procedural matters.

4.5 PROCESS TO LODGE A PROTEST

All riders must approach the Rider advocate if they have an issue/lodge a protest on their behalf. Protests can only be made on the results from the scoring medium showing the order in which riders crossed the finish line, not the decisions of the commissaires panel that are noted in the results such as DNS (Did not Start) DNF (Did not finish) REL (Relegated). Riders only have 15 minutes to process once results are posted. Protests regarding judgement decisions during a competition are not accepted.

5. AWARDS & PRIZING

5.1 SPROCKETS & MINI WHEELERS

All Sprockets and Mini Wheelers will receive an award for participation.

5.2 CHALLENGE, Masters 30+, JUNIOR SUPERCLASS AND SUPERCLASS CATEGORIES

For Challenge, Masters 30+, Junior Superclass and Superclass categories, the following will be provided per round:

Please Note: Merged Category awards / payouts will be awarded based on raced category.

5.3 DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS / PRIZE MONEY

Sprockets, Challenge and Masters 30+ categories will be issued their awards/prize money on the day at the conclusion of the final (or last race for each category).

Noting awards / prizes will only be issued to competitors who ride in the extra moto.

Junior Superclass and Superclass categories will receive their prize money via EFT (as soon as is reasonably practical following the event). Riders are to provide their bank details via email to sydneybmxclub@gmail.com

6. VENUE INFORMATION

The following are prohibited at Sydney BMX Club:

- Pets
- Alcohol
- Smoking (including E-Cigarettes or other vaping devices)

All attendees at the 2024 AusCycling BMX Racing State Series – ACT/NSW Round 7 Sydney BMX are required to adhere to the <u>National Integrity Framework</u>. Failure to do so, or to follow any reasonable direction provided by Sydney BMX Club, or appointed officials at the event, may result in removal from competition.

A reminder this is a National/State level AusCycling event.


Sport Integrity Australia can conduct anti-doping testing at any event or competition. It is your responsibility to ensure you are aware of your obligations and have completed clean sport education.
