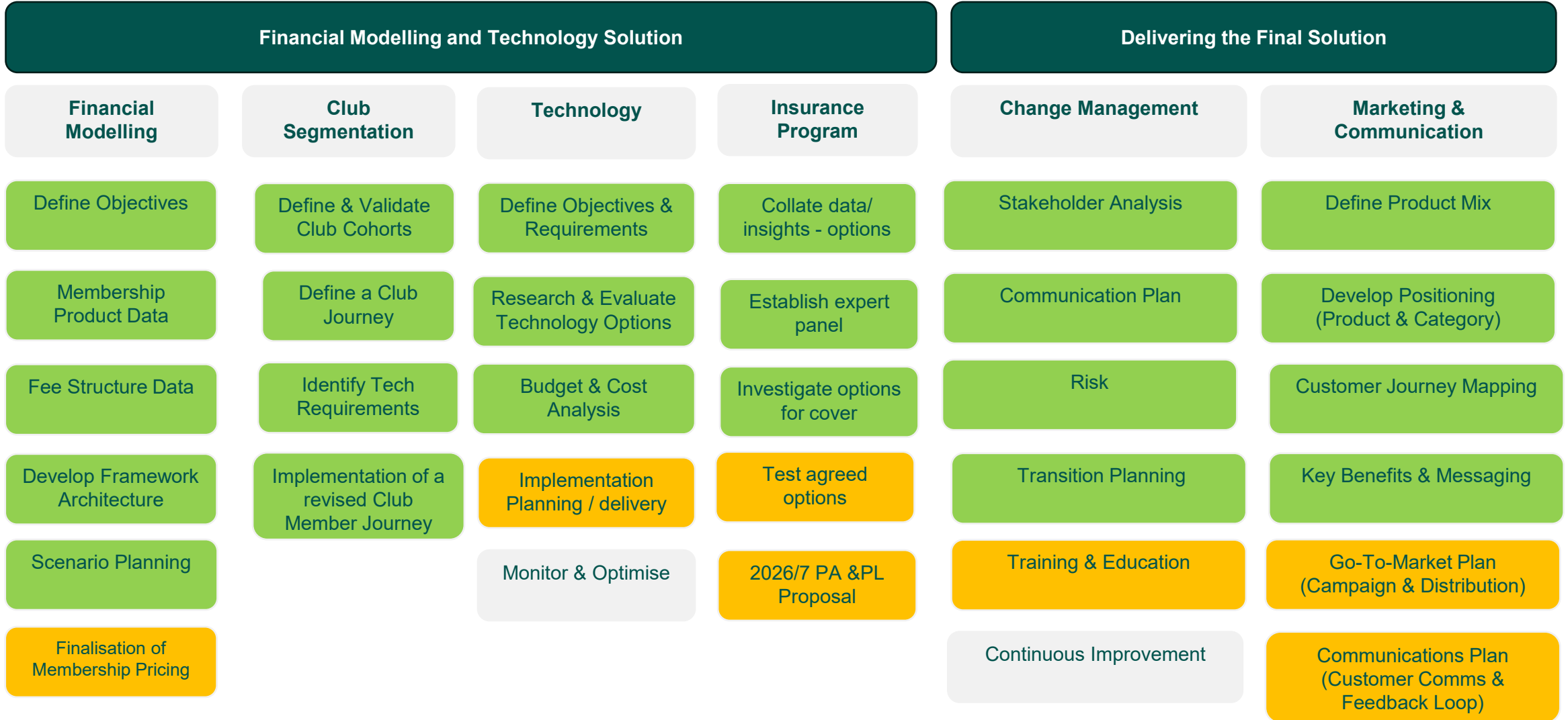

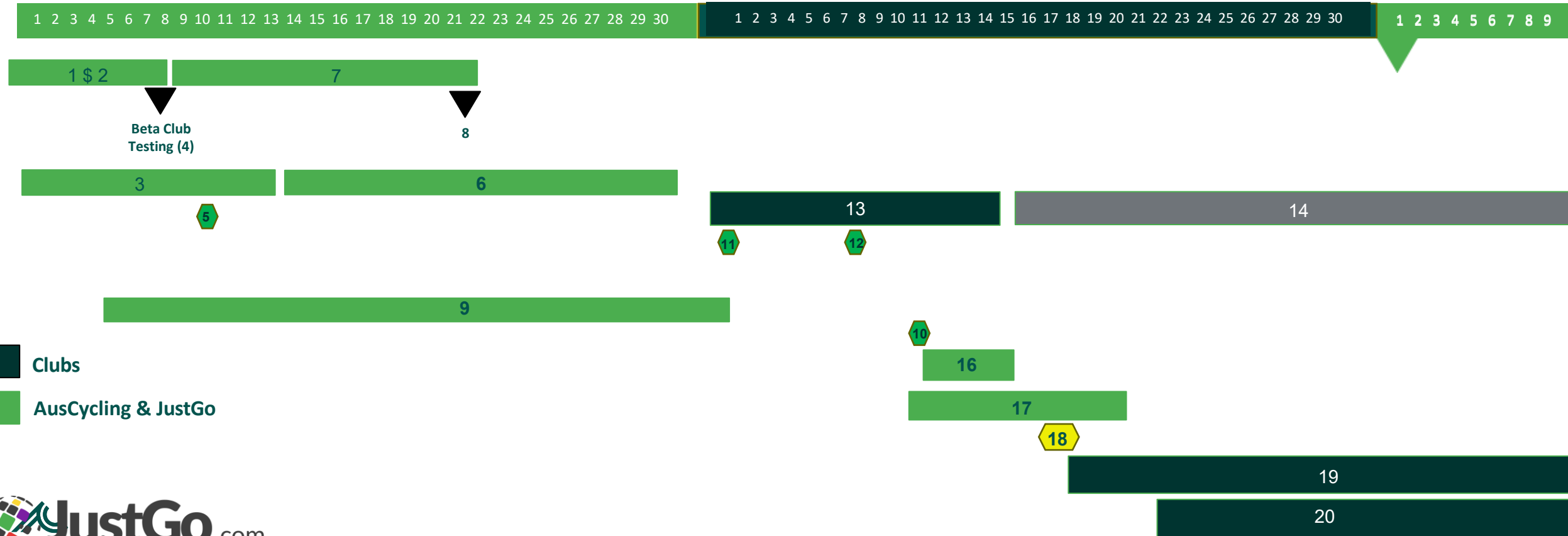

## RFI Process Overview

The proposed membership system has been selected following a thorough and inclusive process involving multiple stakeholders across the sport. Requirements were informed by a range of data sources, with a detailed market scan and formal request process used to identify potential vendors.

5 Different vendors were invited to participate in the RFI process through written submission around fit to requirements and overall company background. The two preferred providers were assessed through

- Detailed system demonstrations
- Ritten submissions covering all requirements
- Background checks
- Testimonials form other sports – sought independently not through the vendor

A panel including independent representatives and AusCycling teams unanimously recommended JustGo.

This recommendation has also been validated through consultation with the National Advisory Committee, State Operations Managers, and club forums, as well as feedback from comparable organisations such as Surfing Australia and Triathlon Australia.

JustGo is considered a strong fit due to its alignment with AusCycling's product strategy and needs of its clubs, its existing presence in the Australian sports sector, and its ability to deliver a high-quality system from day one.

The platform offers opportunities for ongoing innovation and shared capability with other sporting bodies, while also presenting a lower overall risk profile. Financially, the solution is expected to deliver benefits to both AusCycling and its stakeholders.

It was recommended to the board and approved that AusCycling proceed with JustGo as its new membership platform.
