Danny Barber has emerged as a rising track sprint star, progressing from a highly successful junior career into elite competition.

Barber established himself as a dominant force at junior level:

- U17 Flying 200m national record holder
- Oceania Champion – U19 Sprint & Keirin
- Multiple Australian Junior Champion titles

After being elevated to the Australian sprint program environment in his first elite year, Barber made his elite ARA Australian Cycling Team debut in 2025. That same year, he won his first elite national title:

- Australian Champion – Keirin
- Bronze medal – Team sprint at the UCI Track Nations Cup
- Bronze medal – Team sprint at the UCI Track World Championships
- Gold medal – Team sprint at the Oceania Championships
