Felicity Wilson-Haffenden is one of Australia's most exciting young road and track cycling talents, rising rapidly through the ranks after taking up the sport during the COVID-19 Pandemic. Wilson-Haffenden delivered a breakthrough junior season in 2023:

- Gold medal – Individual time trial at the UCI Junior Road World Championships
- Bronze medal – Individual pursuit at the 2023 UCI Junior Track World Championships
- Junior national champion - Road race and individual time trial

Since turning professional with Lidl-Trek in 2024, she has continued to excel on the world stage:

- Gold medal – Mixed team relay at the 2025 UCI Road World Championships
- Elite national champion – Individual time trial at the 2026 RoadNats
- Gold medal – Team pursuit at the 2026 UCI Track World Cup (Perth)
- Elite national champion – Individual pursuit (2024)

Her rapid progression and strong performances have established Wilson-Haffenden as one of Australia's leading prospects for future international cycling success.
