

2026 BJWT Haigslea Road Race

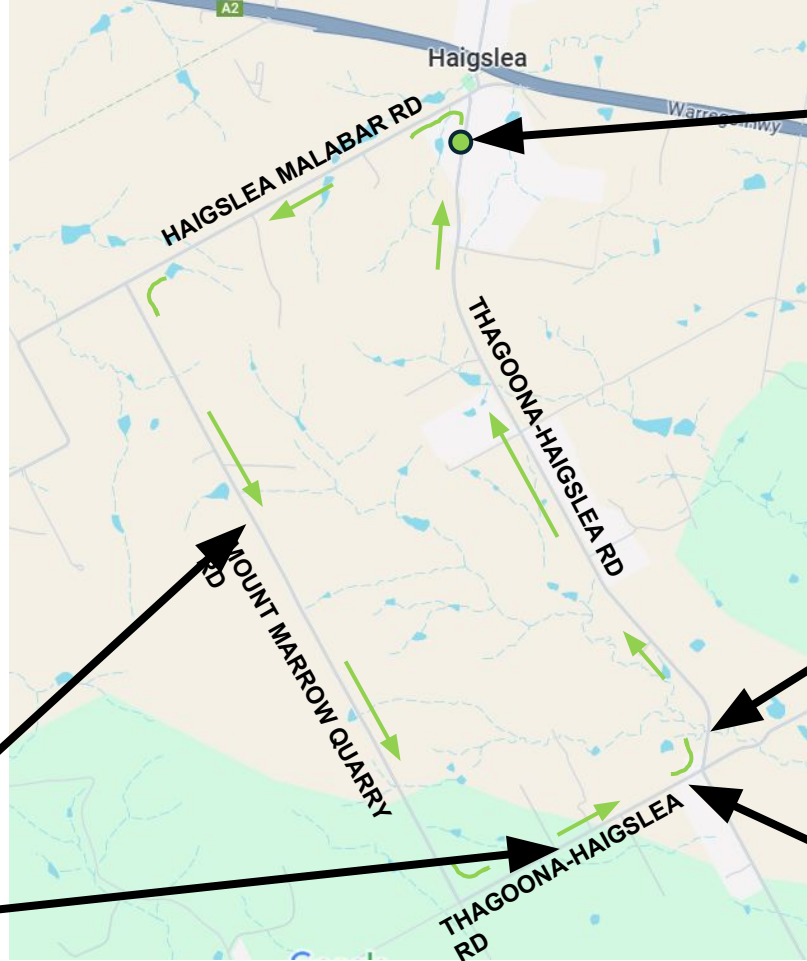
Course condition as of 22-06-2026

Overall, the roads are in good condition. The following 4 pages show more detail and photos for each of the locations shown here.

Please take particular note of page 5 as there will be a short stretch of unsealed road due to some roadworks.

We ask that all BJWT competitor traffic please avoid the roadworks zone entirely on race day. We must minimise traffic in this area.

- Please arrive and depart from Haigslea S.S. via the Warrego Highway
- Please do not drive the course on race day. Not only due to the roadworks, but also for general safety of the races on course.



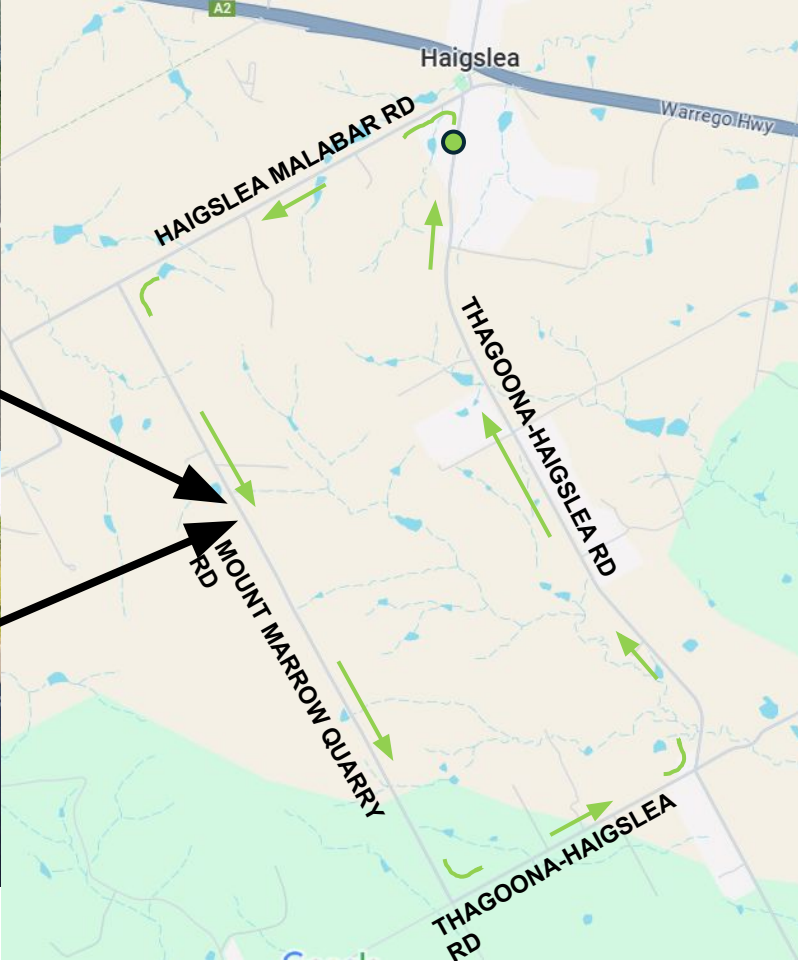
Haigslea State School - race headquarters and start location

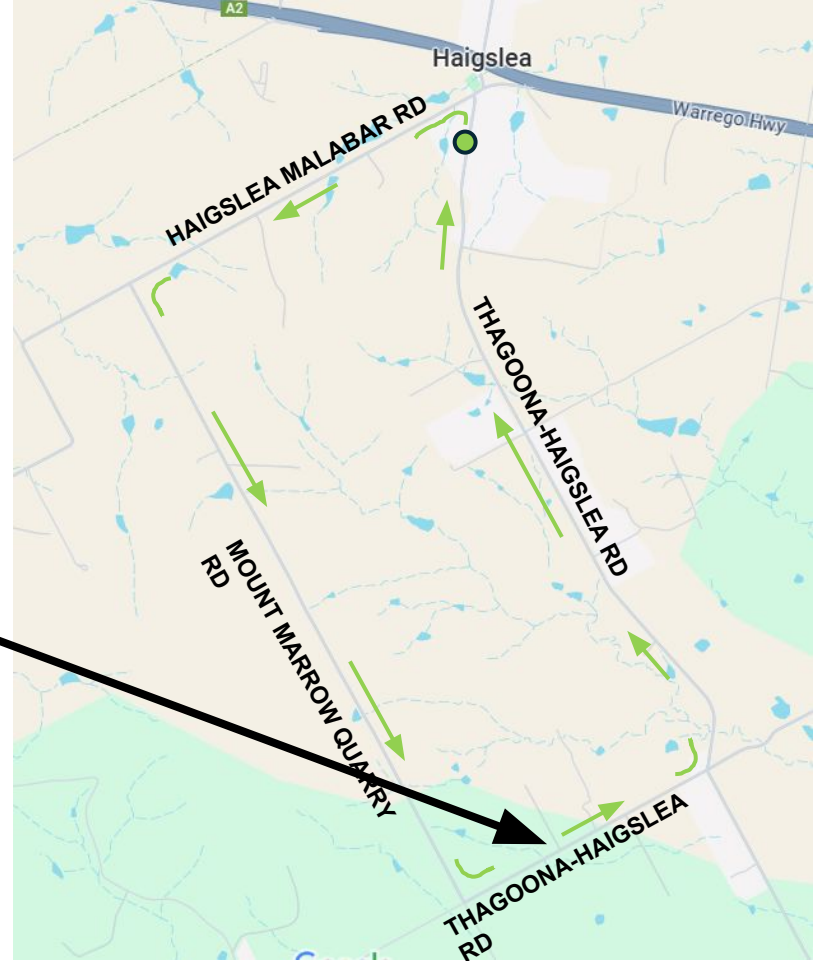


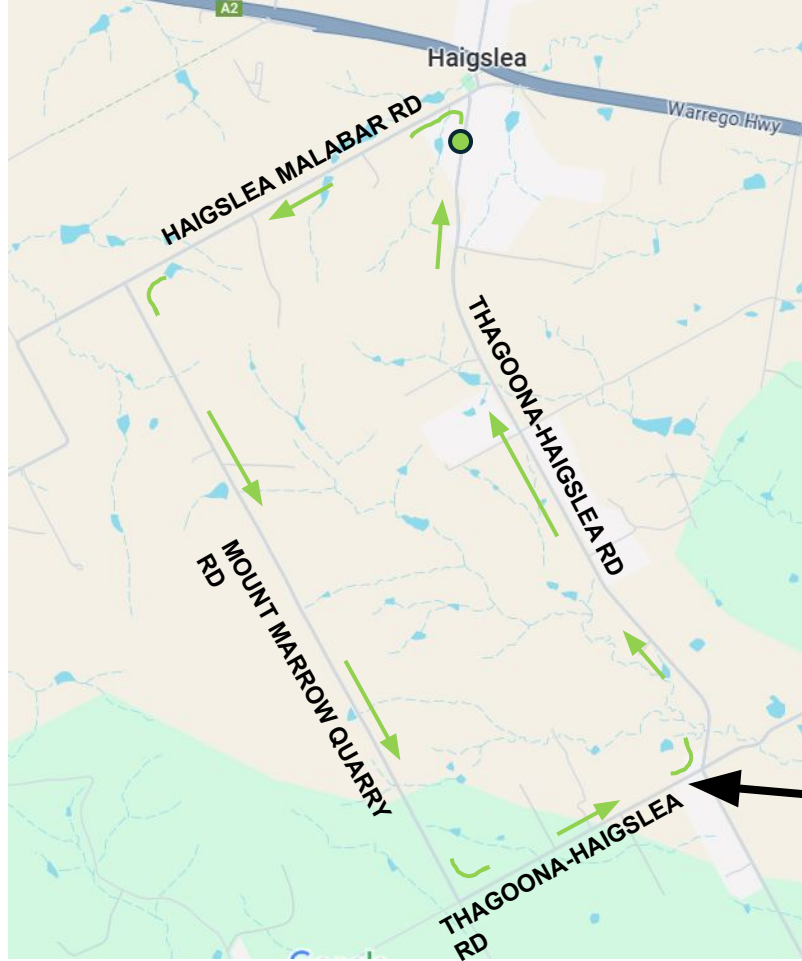
Two potholes here on Mt Marrow Quarry Rd (on uphill section). A council request for repair was submitted so we are hoping these will be filled prior to the tour.

Along this stretch of Thagoona-Haigslea Rd between turns 3 and 4.

The very left hand edge is rough in patches. There are some very minor holes, but mostly just rough, stay clear of the left edge.

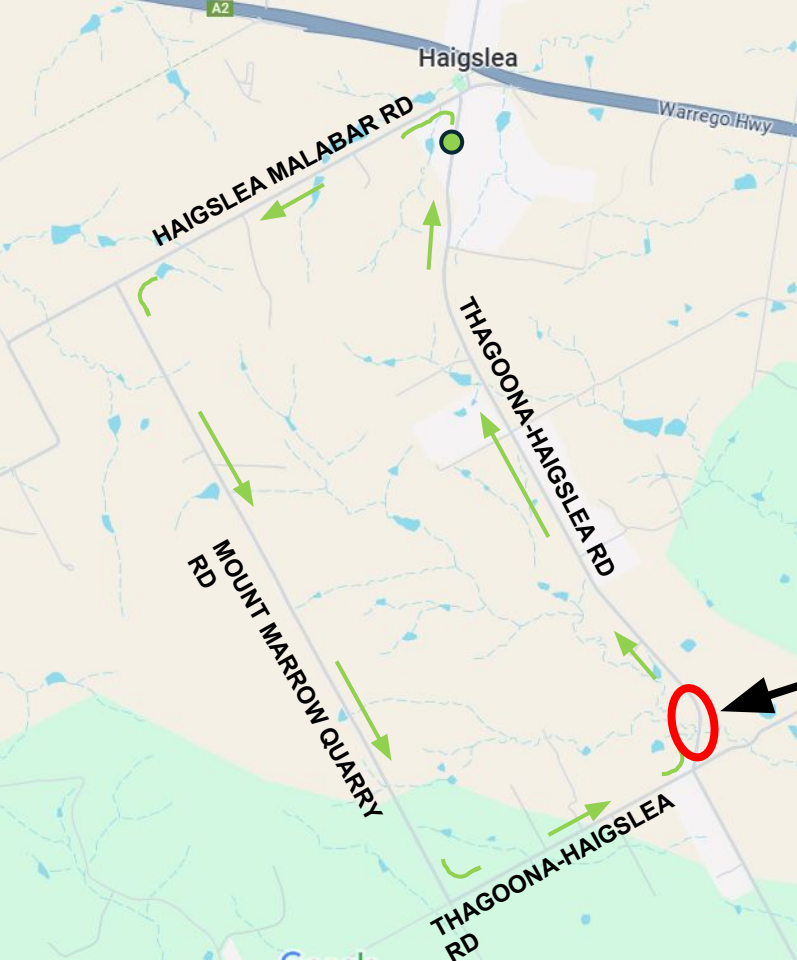
B.
Towards the center of the lane there is also some minor ridging in the bitumen in a couple of spots.





Here on the approach to turn 4, there is some more ridging in the bitumen near the center of the lane.





Just after turn 4, on Thagoona-Haigslea Rd, there is a short stretch of roadworks (approximately 150m-200m long).

This will be a short unsealed section of the course. Although it is unsealed, our races will be able to use the left side of the road (as pictured) which is a smooth, hard-packed surface, it is not a loose gravel type of surface.

We have engaged extra traffic control for this zone to ensure rider safety. Our traffic control will be in place of the current temporary traffic lights at each end.
