Licenses (AusCycling, UCI International & UCI ID)

AusCycling Domestic License (any 12 month)

UCI International License issued by AusCycling
(calendar year)

UCI ID issued and updated by AusCycling (if
you are based in Australia and have an
AusCycling Domestic or International License)

Visa and passport requirements

AusCycling Domestic License

An AusCycling Domestic License is required to be purchased before an International license can be issued.

AusCycling issues licenses for any 12 month period

No longer issued as a card (digital copy only)

This can be used for all Domestic Racing including National Championships.

UCI ID number

1. This is required in addition to a Domestic License to compete in any National Championship events within Australia
2. The UCI ID has to be renewed every calendar year and your domestic license also has to be valid for this period. If your domestic license expires you will need to renew it or your International License is not valid
3. Use the form available on the website
4. Apply in plenty of time before i.e during November for the following year

International License, Club Change & Letter of Good Standing

- An International License is required to compete in any event on the UCI Calendar (excluding National Championships and Oceania Championships when held in Australia).
- It is a requirement to have your correct club / team printed on the license. If you are racing for an international club / team this name is required to be on the license. Contact the Membership Team for this change process.
- A Letter of Good Standing may be required to race in some countries. This indicates you have adequate membership and insurance cover:

Insurance Cover

1. Domestic Race License

- a. Insurance cover only in Australia. If you choose to compete at domestic events in another country without an International license you are not insured.

Most European countries will only accept an International license for all their events including domestic racing.

2. UCI ID

- a. No insurance cover – UCI ID alone does not allow you to race outside of Australia.

3. International License

- I. Insurance cover must be purchased before the license can be issued. The policy must cover racing (some insurers only cover recreational riding) and in the countries you will be travelling and / or racing in
- II. Insurance can be purchased through AusCycling (AC Projects) or through private insurers such as SVL or World Nomads

JUNIOR (U19) SELECTION EVENTS:

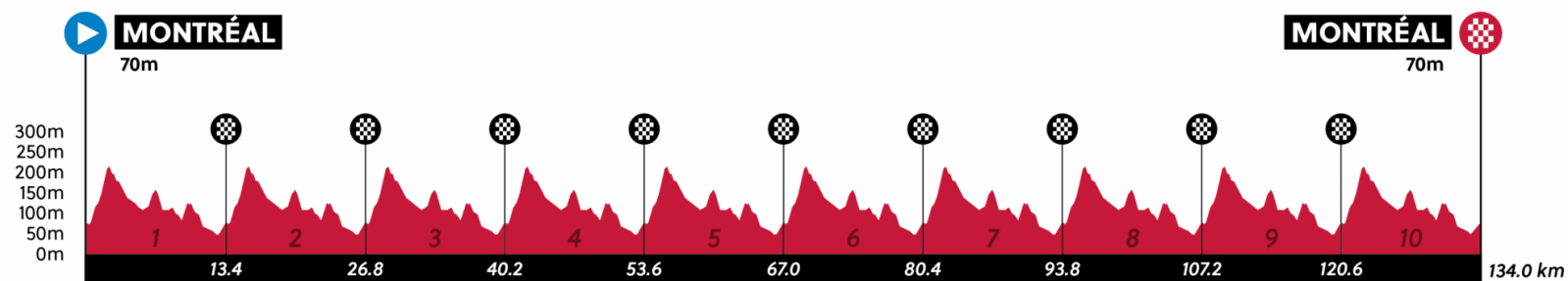
- 2026 AusCycling Road Race National Championships;

- Other major national and international level events for both junior and elite competitions within the Performance Time Period, such as UCI sanctioned international events and AusCycling approved events

Higher weighting will be given to road and time trial courses with distances and conditions similar to those expected at the 2026 UCI Road World Championships

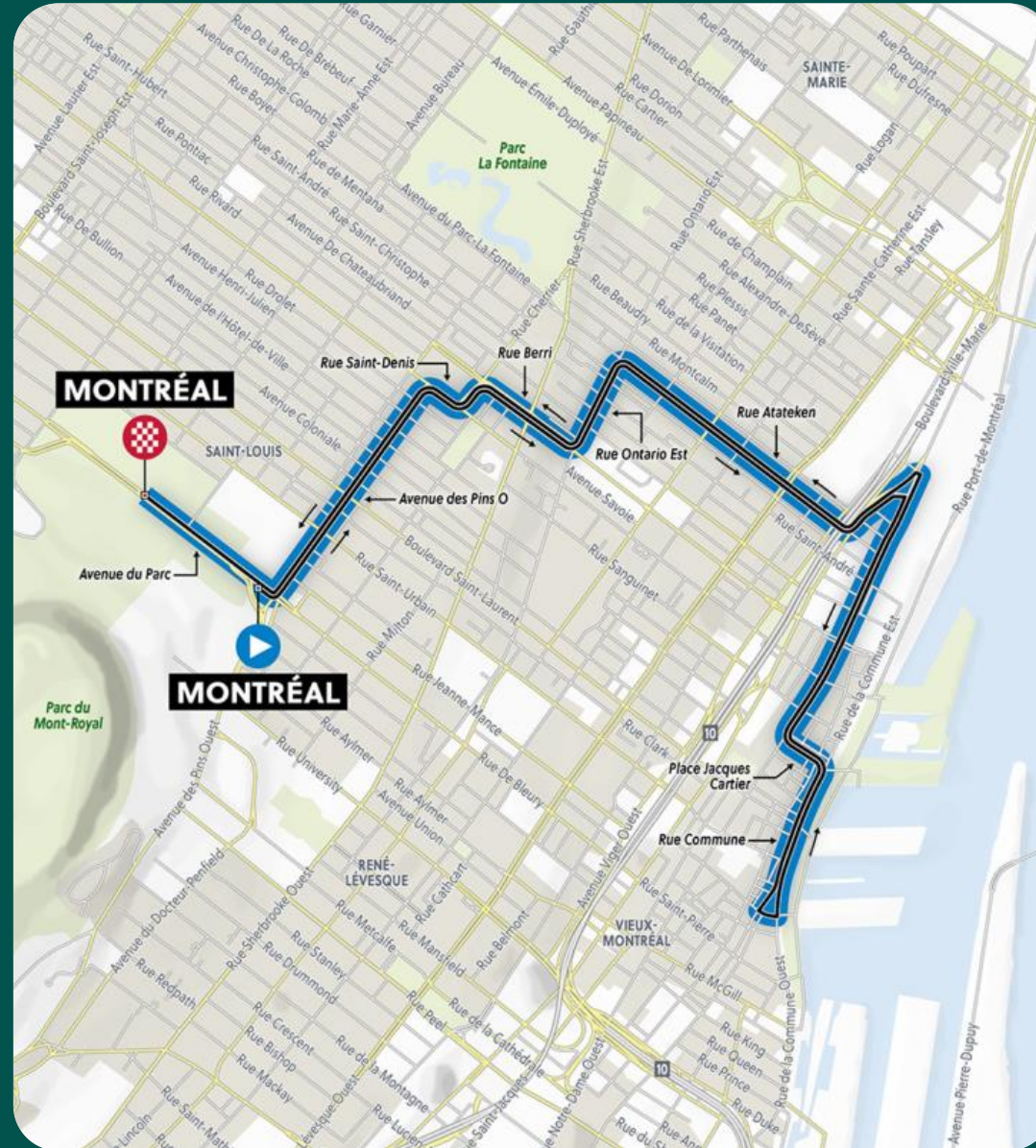
Road Race Circuit
