Kane Perris is one of Australia's leading para cycling talents, rapidly progressing through the sport after being identified through a talent transfer program in 2020.

Competing with pilot Luke Zaccaria, Perris quickly made his mark:

- Qualified for 2024 UCI Para Cycling Track World Championships
- Represented Australia at the Paris 2024 Paralympic Games
- World record – Mixed team sprint B

At the Paris 2024 Paralympics, Perris delivered a strong performance:

- 4th place – 1km time trial B

Perris enjoyed a standout 2025 campaign at the UCI Para Cycling Track World Championships:

- Gold medal – Mixed team sprint B
- Silver medal – Tandem sprint B
- Silver medal – Tandem kilo B

His rapid development and world-class results have established Perris as a key member of Australia's para cycling program.
