Kristina Clonan is one of Australia's leading track sprinters and a reigning Commonwealth Games gold medallist. Originally an endurance rider, Clonan made the decision to switch to sprinting after missing selection for the Tokyo Olympic Games. The move was transformative, with Clonan going on to win

- Multiple national sprint titles
- Gold medal in the 500m time trial at the 2022 Commonwealth Games
- Broke the Commonwealth Games record previously held by Anna Meares.

Clonan has since established herself among the world's top sprinters, achieving results such as:

- Silver medal at the 2023 UCI Track World Championships – 500m time trial
- Represented Australia at the Paris 2024 Olympic Games
- Bronze medal at the 2024 UCI Track World Championships – Team sprint

After missing most of the 2025 season due to injury, Clonan enters the 2026 Commonwealth Games campaign determined to compete on one of the world's biggest stages.
