Luke Zaccaria is an Australian track cycling pilot who has represented Australia at both the Paralympic Games and UCI Para Cycling World Championships.

Zaccaria began his tandem career alongside Brad Henderson, achieving strong early success:

- **Three national titles**
- **Top-six finish at the 2019 UCI Para Cycling Track World Championships**

He later went on to achieve:

- **Bronze medal at the 2022 Commonwealth Games as the pilot for Beau Wootton.**

Since partnering with Kane Perris in 2023, Zaccaria has continued to deliver on the world stage:

- **National records in tandem events**
- **Represented Australia at the 2024 UCI Para Cycling Track World Championships**
- **Represented Australia at the Paris 2024 Paralympic Games**

In 2025, Zaccaria achieved a major career milestone:

- **Gold medal & world record in the mixed team sprint B at the UCI Para Cycling Track World Championships**
