

Terms and Conditions – Win Your 2026 AusCycling Queensland Cycling Experience Prize Draw

1. Promoter

The promoter is AusCycling Ltd (ABN 70 644 149 351), PO Box 180, Fairfield VIC 3078 (“AusCycling”).

2. Eligibility

- The Promotion is open to individuals who are not current AusCycling members at the time of entry (“Eligible Participants”).
- Entry is open to Australian residents aged 18 years or over.
- Entry is free, and no purchase is required.
- Eligible Participants must subscribe to the AusCycling mailing list during the Promotion Period to receive one (1) entry.
- Individuals who enter and subsequently purchase an AusCycling membership during the Promotion Period will remain eligible.
- Employees, contractors, volunteers, National Team athletes of AusCycling and their immediate families are not eligible to enter.

3. How to Enter

- One (1) valid entry will be recorded when an Eligible Participant submits the entry form during the Promotion Period.
- A maximum of one (1) entry per person is permitted.

4. Promotion Period

The Promotion opens at 12:01am AEDT on the date the entry form is first published and closes at 11:59pm AEDT on 25 February 2026.

5. Prize

There is one (1) prize. The prize winner may select from the following components:

Membership Component (Winner's Choice)

The winner may choose one (1) of:

- A 12-month AusCycling Race Membership (valued up to \$400 inc. GST), OR
- A 12-month AusCycling Lifestyle Membership with optional Club Add-On (valued up to \$156 inc. GST).

Queensland Cycling Experience (Winner's Choice)

The winner may choose one (1) optional Queensland cycling experience from the following categories:

- Tour de Brisbane
- Brisbane Cycling Festival
- UCI BMX World Championships
- MTB race experience (as determined with AusCycling)

The experience selection will be coordinated with AusCycling based on availability and event scheduling.

Additional Prize Components:

- Return economy flights for the winner from their nearest major airport to Queensland (valued up to \$1,000 inc. GST).
- Three (3) nights premium accommodation for two people (valued up to. \$1,000 inc. GST).

If the prize is not claimed within 30 days of notification, AusCycling reserves the right to conduct a redraw at the same location.

- Flights are economy class and cannot be upgraded.
