#### **ENTRY PROCESS & COST**

Entry will be online via EntryBoss only. Entries will be uploaded into Sqorz after entries have closed. It is the rider's/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category, and plate number.

Categories will be offered as per the current <u>AusCycling Technical Regulations - General, Annexure</u> <u>5</u> and as per <u>AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX Racing, 1.03(A) SANCTIONING MATRIX</u> (A).

#### **TRANSPONDERS**

- All riders (except sprockets) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this event.
- 20" and 24" bikes will need separate transponders unless prior approval has been received.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active <u>subscription</u>.
- Transponders can be purchased <u>here</u>.

#### **EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)**

- All riders are required to attend the Event Registration.
- All riders must take their bikes to the transponder checking station to register for the event.
- Riders entered in two (2) categories (i.e. 20" and 24") must take both bikes to register in both categories.
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct at the transponder checking station.

### RACE INFORMATION

#### **RACE FORMAT**

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.03.03 a) of the <u>AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX Racing</u>.

The race format for the Atherton Air Time carnival is as follows:

#### **DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS / PRIZE MONEY**

Sprockets, Challenge, and Masters 30 + categories will be issued their awards/prize money on the day at the conclusion of the final (or last race for each category).
