ELIGIBILITY & QUALIFICATION

How do I qualify for the Challenge Class?

The qualification process is detailed in the [Selection Criteria](#) document.

What is the nation's quota allocation?

The nation's quota is determined by the UCI. Up to sixteen (16) riders in each Challenge and Master's level category which is scheduled for competition.

Who is eligible for automatic qualification?

1. A top sixteen (16) finish at the 2024 UCI BMX Racing World Championships.
2. For UCI Aligned categories - Top eight (8) finish at the 2024 GWM BMX Racing National Championships
3. For non-UCI aligned categories -The top finishers to the maximum number of spots reserved as outlined in Selection Criteria

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

What is an Expression of Interest (EOI), and why do I need to submit one?

An EOI is a way to indicate your intention to compete and helps streamline the selection process.

How do I register my EOI?

Can I still register my expression of interest if I am not an automatic qualifier?

Yes, non-automatic qualifiers can still apply. Submit your EOI through the Non-Automatic Qualification EOI link.

TRAVEL & LOGISTICS

Do I need to arrange my own travel and accommodation?

Yes, riders and their families are responsible for their own travel and accommodation arrangements.

Does AusCycling provide transport to & from the Track?

No, Riders are responsible to make their own way to the track.

Are there travel restrictions or visa requirements for Denmark?

Ensure you check Denmark's visa and travel requirements well in advance.

Does AusCycling provide insurance for riders?

Yes, Rider Insurance is for the duration of Competition only and will be included in the rider registration packages. Further details will be provided

Do I need to hold a UCI License?

No, Challenge riders do not require a UCI License. A valid Auscycling license is sufficient.

TEAM APPAREL

Do we need to wear team jerseys for the event?

Yes, team jerseys are required for all team members during the event.

Can we add sponsors and names to our Jersey?

No sponsors or names are permitted on the team Jersey

How do I order team jerseys and apparel?

Team apparel orders will be placed on the online shop. Details about ordering, including deadlines, will be provided in the registration package.

Will my order be sent directly to me, or do I collect it at the event?

We are working with the supplier to have all orders shipped directly to you. Further details will be provided once finalised.

REFUNDS

Can I get a full refund if I cancel my registration?

Refunds may be available if your cancellation is made before the registration cut-off date. Further details, including specific deadlines and conditions, will be provided in the registration packages when they are released
