ENTRY PROCESS & COST

Entry will be online via EntryBoss only. Entries will be uploaded into Sqorz after entries have closed. It is the rider's/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category, and plate number.

Categories will be offered as per the current [AusCycling Technical Regulations - General, Annexure 5](#) and as per [AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX Racing, 1.03\(A\) SANCTIONING MATRIX \(A\)](#).

TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except Participation Categories) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this event.
- 20" and 24" bikes will need separate transponders unless prior approval has been received.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active [subscription](#).
- Transponders can be purchased [here](#).

EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

- All riders are required to attend the Event Registration (sign on) prior to their official practice.
- All riders must take their bikes to the transponder checking station to register for the event.
- Riders entered in two (2) categories (i.e. 20" and 24") must take both bikes to register in both categories.
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct at the transponder checking station.

RACE INFORMATION

RULES AND REGULATIONS

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.03.03 a) of the [AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX Racing](#).

The race format for the 2024 AusCycling BMX State Series – WA Round 7 Hills BMX is as follows:

Challenge/Masters 30+/Jnr Superclass/Superclass	3 Motos, Qualifiers, Finals



AWARDS & PRIZING

SPROCKETS & MINI WHEELERS

All Sprockets and Mini Wheelers will receive an award for participation after their racing concludes on the day.

MASTERS 30+, JUNIOR SUPERCLASS AND SUPERCLASS CATEGORIES

For Masters 30+, Junior Superclass and Superclass categories, the following will be provided per round:

Masters 30+	Prize Money	1st Place (\$100), 2nd Place (\$60), 3rd Place (\$40), 4th – 8th Place (\$20)
Junior Superclass	Prize Money*	1st Place (33%), 2nd Place (23%), 3rd Place (14%), 4th Place (8%), 5th Place (7%), 6th Place (6%), 7th Place (5%), 8th Place (4%)
Superclass	Prize Money^	1st Place (33%), 2nd Place (23%), 3rd Place (14%), 4th Place (8%), 5th Place (7%), 6th Place (6%), 7th Place (5%), 8th Place (4%)
<p>* \$500 prize pool per round (50:50 split male / female) ^ \$2,000 prize pool per round (50:50 split male / female) Superclass prize pool 80/20% payout as per discussion with host clubs. AusCycling will keep hold of the minimum required 20% from final payment amount to clubs.</p>		

Please Note: Merged Category awards / payouts will be based on the Raced Category on the day.

DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS / PRIZE MONEY

Sprockets and Masters categories will be issued their awards/prize money on the day at the conclusion of the final (or last race for each category).

Junior Superclass and Superclass categories will receive their prize money via EFT (as soon as is reasonably practical following the event). Riders are to provide their bank details via email to hillsbmxclub@live.com.au.

VENUE INFORMATION
