Our Commitment to Safe Sport

How [Club Name] is keeping cycling safe, fair and inclusive

[Club Name] is proud to be affiliated with AusCycling and is committed to providing a safe, respectful, fair and inclusive environment for everyone involved in cycling.

As an AusCycling-affiliated club, we operate under the **National Integrity Framework (NIF)**. The NIF establishes standards of behaviour and processes for preventing and dealing with integrity concerns, including bullying, abuse, harassment, discrimination, safeguarding children and young people, competition manipulation and other prohibited conduct.

What does this mean at club level?

Everyone involved with our club is expected to follow AusCycling's integrity policies and standards of behaviour.

We take concerns seriously and will manage complaints at club level where appropriate. Matters that fall under the NIF may be referred to, or reported directly to, AusCycling or Sport Integrity Australia.

You do not need to determine whether a breach has occurred before raising a concern. If something doesn't feel right, speak up.

How can I report a concern?
