

STATE / TERRITORY CHAMPION JERSEY SPECIFICATIONS



Introduction

Being awarded the State/Territory Championships Jersey is an honour for any rider. It is critical for AusCycling to ensure consistency in the manufacture and wearing of the State/Territory Champion jersey. The following outlines the design and ability to wear the State/Territory Champion jersey and champion bands.

State/Territory Champion Jersey

1. A State/Territory Jersey may be awarded to the winner, or the highest placed individual from that State/Territory (based on their primary club).
2. A winner may only be recognised as the State/Territory Champions in one State/Territory per discipline each year.
3. Winners may wear their State/Territory Champion Jersey in all events in the discipline specialty and category in which they won their title and no other event up until the day before the championship event of the following year.
4. For track cycling, Masters riders may wear this jersey in all masters competitions conducted in the discipline in which the State/Territory Championship was won.
5. PMS colours must match:

Design of Jersey

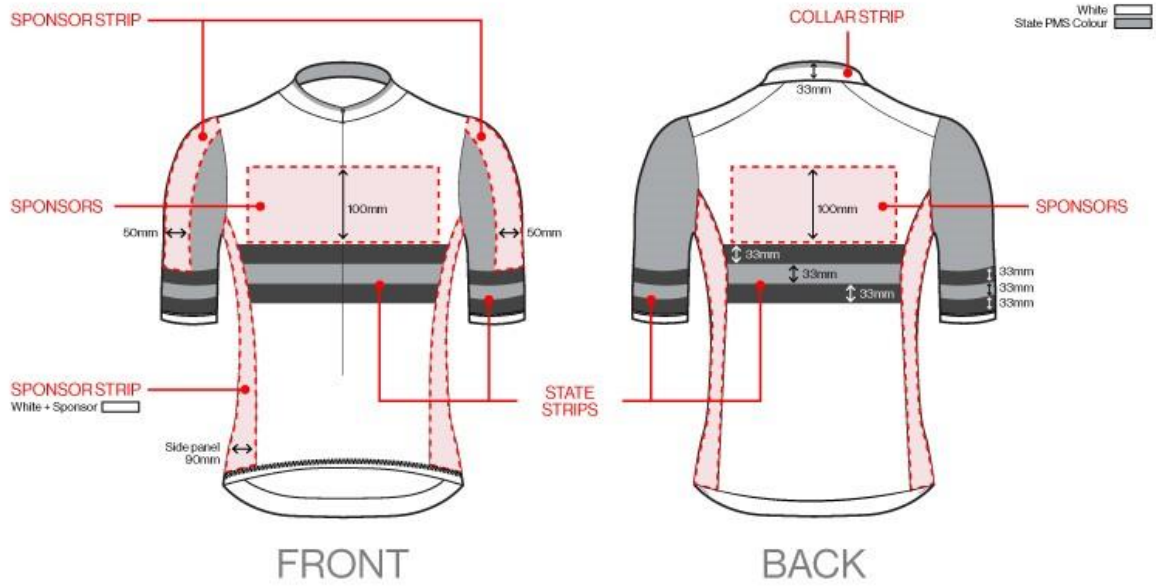
Where an individual or team designs their own State/Territory Champion jersey the following elements must be followed:

- The jersey must be the primary colour
- The sleeves must be White
- Knicks and skinsuit bottoms may be black or team colours
- 33mm Primary (top and bottom) and Secondary (middle) bands across the body (no advertising permitted on the bands)
- State Strip colours on the collar and sleeves (33mm width)
- PMS colours must match the colours in point 7.

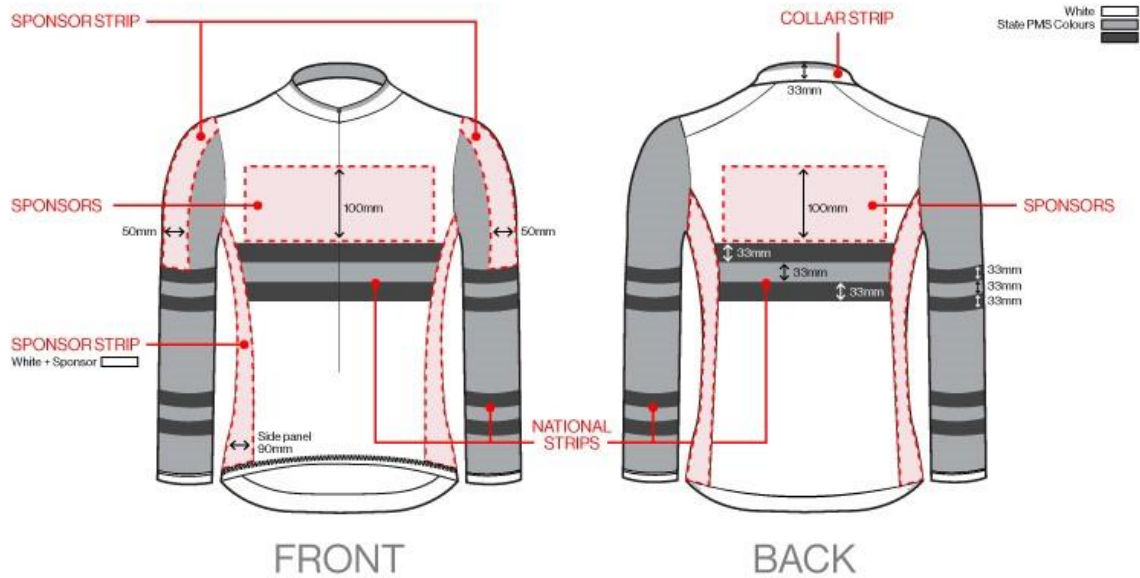

Past State/Territory Champion Jersey

When a rider no longer holds the title of State/Territory Champion the rider may wear piping in national colours on the collar and cuffs of their jersey in the events of the discipline in which they won the title. The piping must follow the following design

- Colour 1, Colour 2, Colour 1 or Colour 3 (if applicable)
- 5-10 mm width

NOTE: Example below is of a Past National Champion Jersey design.



Intellectual Property
