Paralympic Nomination Appeal Workflow

Important components of a Nomination Appeal

Start at Schedule 1: Nomination Appeals Policy

Remember to continually refer to and **closely follow the process and timeframes** stipulated at **Schedule 1: Nomination Appeal Policy**, of the By-Law. The process requires athletes to submit information to different stakeholders. Stakeholder contact information is provided on Slide 3 of this slide deck. A non-nominated athlete may not commence a Nomination Appeal in the NST, unless the **dispute resolution provisions at clause 6. have first been complied with.**

Understand the Grounds for Appeal

An athlete may bring a Nomination Appeal to the NST **only** on one or more of the grounds stipulated in the By-Law at **clause 8**. Athletes are encouraged to **read clause 9**. and **10**. prior to commencing the Appeal process.

What are the costs involved?

As per clause 6.2 (b), there is AUD\$250 application fee to AusCycling. Refer to Slide 3 for AusCycling Bank Details. If the appeal proceeds to the NST, as per clause 9.1 (b), there is AUD\$500 application fee to the NST. Refer to Slide 3 for a link to the NST website which will provide you with further information on the fee and how to apply.

The By-Law refers to Interested Party. Who is an Interested Party?

In a non-Nomination dispute, an additional party may be permitted to participate in a hearing such as an affected athlete (being an athlete who could possibly be displaced from the team if the appeal is successful).
