## General Information

- 1) Bathurst and Orange Cycle Club intend for this carnival to be a fun, friendly weekend for experienced and less experienced riders. We are not racing for sheep stations. Please ride conservatively, safely and have fun!
- 2) We have a very busy program, please arrive at the marshalling area at least 5 minutes before your race starts. Race briefings will occur in marshalling, not on the track.
- 3) The Race Director and President of the Commissaires Panel reserve the right to alter the program due to poor weather, delays or for any other reason.
- 4) U9 and U11 may have a held start.
- 5) Handicaps—Junior and women riders will need their own handler for wheel races. Male riders off the fence.
- 6) Race numbers on back and left side/hip
- 7) Riders, handlers and spectators on the outfield.
- 8) Do not cross the track during racing.
- 9) Hands on handlebars at all times.
- 10) Prizes and prize money to be collected from the sign on desk.
- 11) Country and Metro Championships based on a points score across all three events.
  - 1st—5 points
  - 2nd—3 points
  - 3rd—2 points
  - 4th— 1point



## **Track Rules—Bathurst**

- 1) Rider entry and exit via the gate only. No jumping the fence.
- 2) Be aware of catheads. Carry bikes from the carpark.
- 3) During warm up slow riders are to stay above the blue line, faster riders below.
- 4) Time Trials— Please keep a clear line of sight across the infield for our time keepers for the 1.5 lap time trials.
- 5) Marshalling all other races—near the access gate. Riders enter the track and form up on the fence to await starting instructions.
- 6) Following the finish, one lap roll down then exit at the gate.
- 7) Once track lights are on, no tinted glasses.

## **Track Rules—Orange**

- 1) Rider entry and exit via large gates only. Pedestrian entry and exit via personnel gate. No jumping the fence.
- 2) During warm up slow riders are to stay above the white line, faster riders below.
- 3) Marshalling at the northern gate. Riders enter the track and form up on the fence between the entry and exit gates to await starting instructions.
- 4) Following the finish, one lap roll down, ride under the riders forming up for the next race, then exit via the southern gate. Slow riders will be required to wait on the infield.
