- Riders may only enter their correct racing age and gender category for the National Championships.
- For a category to be held, at least five (5) riders must be registered in that category.
- Riders entered into Elite/U23/Junior Elite/Masters, may also enter Superclass/Junior Superclass
- Riders entered into Para BMX, may also enter into their relevant age category.

#### 3.3 ENTRY PROCESS

Entry will be online via EntryBoss only. Entries will be uploaded into Sqorz after entries have closed. It is the rider/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct.

The cost of entry for the BMX National Championships and Pre-Championships will be:

\* Riders entering Cruiser as a secondary category will receive a discount (i.e. 20" and Cruiser, or Junior Superclass and Cruiser). This discount only applies if Cruiser entry is submitted at the same time as the entry for the other category. Any rider wishing to add a Cruiser entry at a later stage will not receive the discounted entry.

#### 3.5 SCRATCHING & REFUNDS

Riders who have entered and are no longer able to attend, can use the EntryBoss scratching mechanism prior to the scratching cut off listed above in section 3.4. If a rider scratches in EntryBoss prior to the scratching cut off date, they will automatically be refunded the entry fee via EntryBoss.

After the scratching cut off date has passed, in order to obtain a refund, riders must request a refund via email to <u>events@auscycling.org.au</u>, with a copy of their medical certificate attached. The refund request and medical certificate must be received by AusCycling prior to race day. For more information, please view the <u>AusCycling</u> <u>Refund Policy</u>.

#### 3.7 BMX CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

- All clubs will automatically be entered.
- There is no entry fee/ entry form required.



#### 3.8 PARTICIPATION & MEMBERSHIP

- Championship Categories (Elite/U23/Junior Elite/Masters)
  - Entries are closed to international competitors, and it is important to be aware of the following criteria, which must be met to be eligible to compete in the National Championships:
    - Australian citizens (Australian passport holders) who hold a current AusCycling Off-Road or All Disciplines membership or a UCI licence with an Australian designation.
- All Other Categories (Mini Wheelers/Sprockets/Challenge/Para BMX, Junior Superclass/Superclass)
  - Entries are open to members of any National Federation. Australian riders must be aware of the following criteria:
    - The event will be open to all riders holding an AusCycling Race Membership: All Disciplines or Off Road only. No four (4) week trial or day licenses are permitted.

#### 3.9 TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except Sprockets and Mini Wheelers) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this
  event.
- 20" and cruiser bikes will need separate transponders unless prior approval has been received.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active <u>subscription</u>. Transponders can be purchased <u>here</u>.

#### 3.10 RACE PLATES

- Race Plates will be issued by AusCycling and must be worn for the duration of the event, including any
  official practice sessions.
- All Riders will nominate their plate number (maximum 3 digits) when registering. *Due to timing of state title events in 2024 and close of entries, no State Plates will be accepted.*
- Riders with duplicate plates in the same category may be required to add an 'X' on their plate number.
- Where a duplicate plate is identified, the following process will be used:
  - Where riders have an allocated plate number (i.e. 1A) and a category is merged the rider who has earnt the respective plate number in the designated category will keep that plate number, with the other rider required to add an 'X' on their plate number.
    - Where neither rider received the allocated plate number in the merged category, the following steps shall occur to determine who is required to add an 'X' on their race number, until the duplication is resolved:
      - 1. The rider who is a member of the host club will keep that plate number.
      - 2. The rider who is a member of the host state/territory will keep that plate number.
      - 3. The rider who entered the event first will keep that plate number.
  - Where riders personally choose a plate number and two (2) or more riders select the same plate number, the following steps shall occur to determine who is required to add an 'X' on their race number, until the duplication is resolved:
    - 1. If a category is merged, the rider who entered into the designated category will keep that plate number.
    - 2. The rider who is a member of the host club will keep that plate number.
    - The rider who is a member of the host state/territory will keep that plate number.
    - The rider who entered the event first will keep that plate number.

Once the number has been allocated based on a rider's request this will be the number allocated for the event with no further changes permitted.

To accommodate the timing of entry closures for the National Championships (Including Pre Champs and Round 6) and the running of respective State Title events, AusCycling will only accept current Australian and World plate holders. State plate numbers will not be accepted.



#### 3.11 EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

Details of event registration will be available in the event schedule which dan be found here.

- All riders are required to attend the Event Registration (sign on & pack collection), prior to the commencement of the warmup sessions on their relevant race day.
- All riders must take their bikes to the transponder checking station to register for the event.
- Riders entered in two (2) categories (i.e., 20" and 24") must take both bikes to register in both categories.
- Parents/guardians must scan Sprocket/Mini Wheeler membership at the transponder checking station, but they are not required to bring bikes with them.
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct at the transponder checking station.

#### **4** RACE INFORMATION

Please read the below information carefully regarding race information

#### 4.1 RULES & REGULATIONS

The event will be conducted under the BMX rules and regulations of AusCycling (AC) and the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI). This Technical Guide is supplementary to the following:

- <u>AusCycling Technical Regulations: General</u>
- <u>AusCycling Technical Regulations: BMX</u>
- <u>AusCycling Technical Regulations: Para-Cycling</u>
- UCI Regulations BMX

#### 4.2 RACE FORMAT

Current UCI Rules apply using Scrambled Moto transfer system for all categories except for participation. Block format may apply pending rider entries. Gate positions for Motos will be random computer drawn. Total points to end of motos followed by Qualifiers and Finals. Gate positions for Qualifiers and Finals are in order of lap time from the previous Stage or Round.

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.03.03 a) of the <u>AusCycling Technical Regulations: BMX</u>.

The race format for the 2024 AusCycling BMX Racing National Championships is as follows:

#### 4.3 CORPORATE TEAM SCORING

Points calculation for Corporate Teams will be as follows:

• Points will be issued to riders for Motos and the Final (will not include Qualifiers) as follows:

- Scores will be taken from the top four (4) riders from each Corporate Team, using the following conditions:
- The top four (4) riders can come from any category (excluding Sprockets and Mini Wheelers).
- For riders entering more than one (1) category the best results from one (1) of those categories will be considered.
- For merged categories the points will be assigned in accordance with the entered category.
- In the event of a tie between Corporate Teams, the result will be decided by:
- Greatest number of 1st place results across the whole race
- Greatest number of 2nd place results across the whole race
- Greatest number of 3rd place results across the whole race
- Greatest number of 4th place results across the whole race
- Greatest number of 5th place results across the whole race
- Greatest number of 6th place results across the whole race
- Greatest number of 7th place results across the whole race
- Greatest number of 8th place results across the whole race
- An 'index' for riders is calculated by comparing the best time of each rider with the average time for the entry category of the rider. A faster than average best time results in positive index. A slower than average best time results in negative index. The indexes are totaled and the team with the most points is determined to be the winner.

#### Please Note:

• There must be at least three (3) Corporate Teams entered per event, for Corporate Teams to run at that event.



#### 4.4 BMX CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP SCORING

Points calculation for the BMX Club Championship will be as follows:

• Points will be awarded in each of the Motos and the Final (i.e. will not include Qualifiers) as follows:

- Scores will be taken from the top four (4) riders from each Club, using the following conditions:
- The top four (4) riders can come from any category (excluding Sprockets and Mini Wheelers).
- For riders entering more than one (1) category the best results from one (1) of those categories will be considered.
- In the event of a tie between Clubs, the result will be decided by:
- Greatest number of 1st place results across the whole race
- Greatest number of 2nd place results across the whole race
- Greatest number of 3rd place results across the whole race
- Greatest number of 4th place results across the whole race
- Greatest number of 5th place results across the whole race
- Greatest number of 6th place results across the whole race
- Greatest number of 7th place results across the whole race
- Greatest number of 8th place results across the whole race

An 'index' for riders is calculated by comparing the best time of each rider with the average time for the entry category of the rider. A faster than average best time results in positive index. A slower than average best time results in negative index. The indexes are totaled and the team with the most points is determined to be the winner.

#### 4.5 ANTI DOPING CONTROL

Anti-Doping Testing may be conducted at this event by Sport Integrity Australia. It is the responsibility of the rider to ensure they are not required for testing prior to their departure post-race.

Anti-Doping facilities will be in the portable site office (refer to site map). Please see an event staff member for assistance on accessing these locations.

#### 5.2 ALLOCATION OF AWARDS & PRIZES

#### 5.3 DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS & PRIZING
