Discipline Specific Selection Criterion

2025 UCI E-SPORT WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS Semi-finals Qualifier, 3 October 2025 Elite Men and Women



1. General

- Athletes will be required to earn 2025 UCI E-Sport World Championships Team Semi Final Qualifier selection in accordance with clause 1 of the *AusCycling Selection Policy for UCI World Championships*, and this discipline specific document of the AusCycling (AC) selection criteria.
- 12 Objectives: See clause 1 of the AusCycling Selection Policy for UCI World Championships.
- I.3 Performance Time Period:

Elite men and women:

1 January 2025 – 12 August 2025

1.4 Team size: AusCycling will determine Team size prior to the E-sport World Championships Semi-final Qualifier and may choose not to fill all available quota positions. Based on UCI quotas for Australia, a maximum of seven (7) men and four (4) women may be considered for selection.



2. Selection Eligibility

- 2.1 To be eligible for selection, athletes MUST:
 - 2.1.1 Meet the eligibility criteria stipulated at clause 2.1 of the *AusCycling Selection Policy for UCI World Championships*.
 - 2.1.2 At a minimum, have their <u>name listed on the Sport Integrity Australia Daily Testing Pool</u>.
 - 2.1.3 Be a minimum of MyWhoosh Level 10 at the time of submitting an Expression of Interest.
 - 2.1.4 Submit an expression of interest by the closing date listed in clause 5. and provide the requested information in support of their application, <u>including verified power data</u>.

3. Selection Criteria and Performance Standards

SELECTIONS

- 3.1 Automatic and non-automatic selections will be determined using the standards listed in 3.4 and 3.5.
- 3.2 If quota places remain after all automatic selections have been made, the Selectors, at their absolute discretion, may nominate additional athletes that meet the objectives stated in clause 1.2.
- 3.3 All non-automatic selections must meet the eligibility criteria stated at clause 2 Selection Eligibility, and on any, all, or none of the following factors, at the absolute discretion of the National Selection Panel, which may or may not be exercised:
 - Performance in Esports events with course terrain and conditions like those at the 2025 UCI Esports World Championship Semi-Final Qualifier event, during the performance time-period.
 - 3.3.2 Capacity to fulfil role as protected leader.
 - 3.3.3 Capacity to fulfil support roles.
 - Consideration of the power data requested at 2.1.4. All data provided must align with the standard at 3.5.1 and the Performance Time Period at clause 1.3.

PERFORMANCE STANDARDS

3.4 Elite Men and Women

Automatic Selection will be determined using the following criteria in order:

- 3.4.1 Top 10 finish at the 2024 UCI ESport World Championships.
- 3.4.2 Top 2 finish at the 2025 National ESport Championships.
- 3.5 Non-Automatic Selection Performance Considerations
 - 3.5.1 Verified power data (including source) for 15secs, 1min, 5min, 20min in absolute and w/kg.



4. Schedule for World Championship Team Selection

4.1 The timeframes for the selection process of the World Championships Team to contest the 2025 UCI Esport World Championships are:

Selection Timelines

- Friday, 1 August 2025 Expressions of Interest Open
- Tuesday, 12 August 2025 (5Pm AEST) Expressions of Interest Close
- Friday, 15 August 2025 (5PM AEST) Final team selections forwarded to AusCycling CEO for endorsement.
- Monday, 18 August 2025 (5PM AEST) Athletes receive confidential notification of selection / non-selection to the Esport World Championship Team
- Wednesday, 20 August 2025 (5PM AEST) Closing date for appeals to be lodged against non-selection (refer to the AusCycling Selection Appeals Policy for UCI World Championships, clause 7)
- Week of Monday, 25 August 2025 Week scheduled for appeal hearings, if required
- · Friday, 29 August 2025 (5PM AEST) Final Esport World Championship Team announced by AusCycling.
